Who/What is "The Group"

Courses are normally conducted at the customer's location by a mobile training team (MTT). This allows more ready access by more personnel from the customer's organization while keeping costs to a minimum. As a part of most MTT training "The Group" offers a unique "host program option" which provides the customer with a designated number of tuition free slots to the program(s) they host.

"The Group" also conducts training at a variety of state of the art training complexes to include the ISOTF. The ISOTF includes 68+ acres of state of the art ranges and maneuver areas. In addition the ISOTF boasts access to over 3000+ acres of training areas via a unique lease program to include access to two rivers and a multitude of varied environments. The ISOTF boast specialized capabilities unlike any other in the world providing live fire training support that allows the user to train as close to the operational environment as possible.

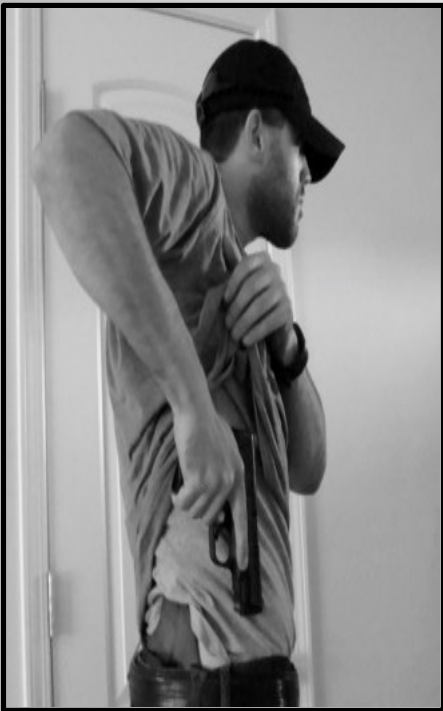
