NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Under RRS 87, the S16 Class Rules will apply with these amendments: Main and Jib class only.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all Sweet 16 sailors
- 2.2 Eligible sailors are required to register at <u>LQYC.com</u> to reserve a Sweet 16. LQYC will provide the skipper's name to the front gate guard house for easy access to Lake Quivira. (Only the skipper's name is needed. Anyone else in the vehicle is allowed.)
- 2.3 LQYC provides the yachts for the Regatta, with rudders, tillers, bailers, painters, etc. A life jacket must be on board for each sailor. We have Five Club-owned Sweet 16s for use by guest sailors and many others that we could borrow from an owner. If a Zebra Mussel egg finds its way into our lake, it will devastate our lake and our irrigation system. Most of the lakes in the Midwest now have Zebra mussels. They cannot be eradicated except by completely draining a lake and leaving the lakebed dry for some time. We irrigate the golf course with lake water (which is better for the environment and also free). If Zebra Mussels get in, it would be a significant initial expense to convert the golf course irrigation system to a municipal water supply. We would pay for water for irrigation forever. LQ does not allow any guest boats. Even when a Lake Quivira member purchases a brand new boat, still in shrink-wrap, that boat is subject to a two-week quarantine. Lifejackets and lines can carry the invisible Zebra Mussel eggs. Please be cognizant. If your lifejacket, lines, or sails were in the water of another lake in the two weeks before the event, please ask us to help you get a replacement that you can borrow rather than be nonchalant. Thank you.
