

# Rules & Guidelines

For Outdoor Fireweed Community Market Vendors, Community Groups, and Buskers

## Changes for 2020

- Vendors can reserve spaces in certain circumstances. See items 8. & 9. page 2 and table on page 3

*Secured spots are available for seasonal vendors with a minimum of one (1) year at the Fireweed Market in good standing. If you fail to give 24 hours notice of any absent markets, the secured spot may be revoked.*

- A fee structure for co-operative groups or collectives. See item 12. page 4.

*Registered co-operative groups may sell under one name. Each selling member of the co-operative must pay for a general membership and the collective group must purchase two (2) vendor registrations.*

- A sound dampener may be required if using your own generator. See item 16. page 4.

- An allowance for visiting vendors has been introduced. See item 20. page 5.

*'Travelling Artists' are permitted for a maximum of two (2) market per season upon approval of the Market Staff/Board of Directors. As a Travelling Artist, all rules and guidelines outlined in this document apply, with the exception of rule number two (2).*

- Weekly booth rental rates have increased from \$22/day to \$24/day. Full season rates increased from \$250/year to \$280/year. See page 6.

- Youth, Senior and NGO rates are discounted 25% (previously 50%) See page 6.

- 'Travelling Artists' are permitted for a maximum of two (2) market per season upon approval of the Market Staff/Board of Directors. As a Travelling Artist, all rules and guidelines outlined in this document apply, with the exception of rule number two (2).
