About our locations	Accessibility	Toilets
 Abingdon and Witney college A quiet meadow with long grass	We use a meadow at the back of the college. We walk to it from the car park - it's a very short 2 minute walk. The ground is rough and has some inclines. There isn't a solid path so it can be muddy when wet. We have tents for rain cover.	We use the toilet in the main barn area. It is accessible for a wheelchair. We also use their outdoor hand wash that has warm running water.
 Asthall Manor A quiet walled garden with a barn	We use a field and the walled garden at Asthall Manor. The ground is grassy and on a gentle incline. There is a barn for rain cover.	There are 2 compost toilets in shed like structures that have steps to access them. There is cold water in a tap and we use flasks warm water for hand wash.
 Notgrove A quiet woodland with bird song	There is a bump farm track that leads to our camp. We usually meet at the farm gate and do a 5 minute walk to the camp. It is possible to drive closer for those unable to walk far. The camp area is on a slight incline with some roots and stumps.	The toilet is a camping toilet in a tent. The hand wash is in bowls using flasks for warm water.
 Westwell A quiet woodland with bird song	The camp is accessed through the wood with a steep ramp at the start and uneven ground. We can provide closer access for anyone with mobility issues. The camp area is flat with some roots and stumps.	The toilet is a camping toilet in a tent. The hand wash is in bowls using flasks for warm water.
