

Fat Squirrel Outdoor is a rural woodland location accessed by a bumpy farm track. There is a parking area very close to the woodland, the car park has a rough hardcore style surface. There are trodden in pathways through the woodland that relatively even, with some tree roots. There is a campfire area with the fire set in the ground, surrounded by logs and bench seating.

Our toilet is a camping toilet in a pop-up camping tent next to the woodland.

The woodland itself is relatively quiet with birdsong and a distant sound of traffic. We provide a quiet hammock as a quiet space away from the other young people and time out from activities.
