Hello from Iacoboni and George Nye Libraries! Spring is here and there's so much happening at your Lakewood libraries!

At Iacoboni, all ages are invited to our latest "Puzzle Swap" happening on Saturday, March 1st. Bring a puzzle or two to swap with other puzzle lovers in the community. In May, Iacoboni will be hosting our first ever "Baby Band Fest." The popularity of our Baby Band program has inspired us to hold a three day early literacy music festival for kids 0-5 and their caregivers. Be on the look out for more information as we get closer to the date.

If you have teens in your life invite them to join our Teen Advisory Board (TAB). TAB meets every third Thursday of the month to discuss ways the library can meet the needs of teens in the community, and there's also a fun activity after the meeting.

Adults are invited to join us for our monthly book club. We meet on the last Tuesday of the month at 6pm and the last Wednesday of the month at 3pm. We also want to give a big thank you to the FOLL for your help with our very successful "Introduction to Scrapbooking" program held in January; there was so much interest we're looking to make it a recurring program!

George Nye is still excited about our recent makeover and, if you haven't seen our new look, maybe one of our upcoming special programs will be just the excuse you need to visit! In March, Nye will be hosting several special programs for all ages, starting with Toddler and Me Yoga on Wednesday, March 5th from 12:30pm - 1:15pm. Toddlers and their caregivers with any level of experience are welcome in this class for beginners (registration is required). For school age children, join us on Wednesday March 19th at 4pm for "Kid's Cooking with CrEATive Plate." CrEATive Plate will teach kids and their caregivers the fundamentals of cooking with a nutritional component; and not to leave out the adults, on Tuesday March 11th George Nye will host Danza Azteca Xochipilli at 6pm. SCHOLARSHIP TIME!

The Friends of the Lakewood Libraries (FoLL) is now accepting applications from either high school seniors or those who are out of high school who would like to continue their education in any kind of college, university, or trade school. All applicants must demonstrate a strong desire to further their education by enrolling in an institution of this kind. The scholarships will be in amounts ranging from \$500.00 to \$1,500.00. All applicants and/or an immediate family member must have volunteered for FoLL or one of the Lakewood libraries, which are the Angelo lacoboni Library or the George M. Nye Library.

Applicants will be judged on not only their GPA in school, but also their active citizenship in the community and their school. Letters of recommendation will be required to show character, effort, leadership, and academics. There is also a photo submission requirement and an essay requirement. Because of the frequency of the use of artificial intelligence, extra scoring points can be obtained by writing the essay in the library with Terry Stuyvesant supervising. She should be contacted for an appointment by Saturday, March 22, 2025 at 562-441-1697. Contact may be made by either text or phone call.


