



Who Can Apply



- High school seniors preparing to graduate
- Students currently enrolled in an accredited college, university, or trade school

Selection Criteria



<u>Application Requirements</u>



- Statement of volunteer service with FoLL or the libraries
- Three letters of recommendation that speak to your character and accomplishments
- A personal essay (theme to be announced when applications open)

<u>Timeline</u>

- Scholarship applications open: March 2026
- Recipients announced: April 2026
