


FOGS GLOBAL DAIRY INDICES REPORT FOR MARCH 2025

The dairy market development for March 2025 in India and world shows favorable trends for dairy farmer with rising milk prices and falling feed price indices. Though the intensity of global developments in milk price trends are much higher than in India, there is a indication for rising dairy demand nationally.

From this month onwards, a global feed price indicator is also added to show the relative situation with the national developments. It can be clearly seen that global feed price indices have fallen significantly in last 2 years, while Indian feed ingredients indices have been almost stable with the exception of soya meal. Also, exceptionally fodder price indices continue to rise signifying rising demand amidst shortage in the upcoming summer season.

Global milk indices saw a 30% jump in 2025 over previous year, while Indian derived dairy indices show a upward trend of 15% only signifying significant potential for Indian dairy market to compete globally.

Fogs global Producer price indices in India are however at a much lower level being 7% lower in 2024-25 over previous year. It is highly likely to see rising trends in the producer prices in the next months.

Global feed price indices has been 14% lower than previous year, while Indian feed prices only 2% lower however fodder price indices have begin to rise in 2025.

Among feed ingredients, soya extract and mustard cake have a significant fall in price index however cotton extract and rice bran are showing rising trends, overall there is not much significant drop in the cattle feed indices.

Note: Method used: The milk price index is developed with the base year as 2011-12 considering the year having similar national and global milk producer prices and to keep in tandem with the government published data referenced to this year. FOGS GLOBAL NETWORK brings a monthly preview of the dairy prices development. Since milk price in India has a wide range, we have developed a producer mik price index using the monthly weighted SMP and Butter prices from NCDFI.

The derived milk producer price index for India is based on the wholesale SMP and butter prices for the national markets and backward calculation for its processing, marketing and inflation considered.

The CPI for milk and milk product is taken from <u>ceicdata.com</u> for time series April 2011-January 2025 and latest from published reports and news media on retail milk prices of major stakeholders.
