

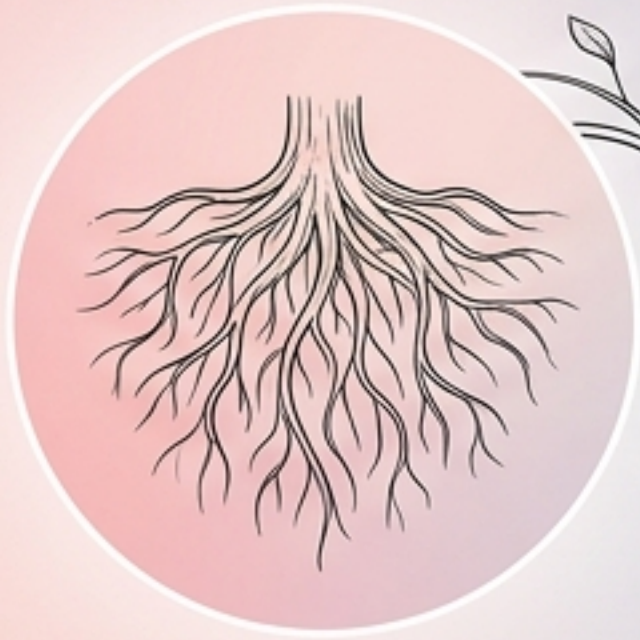

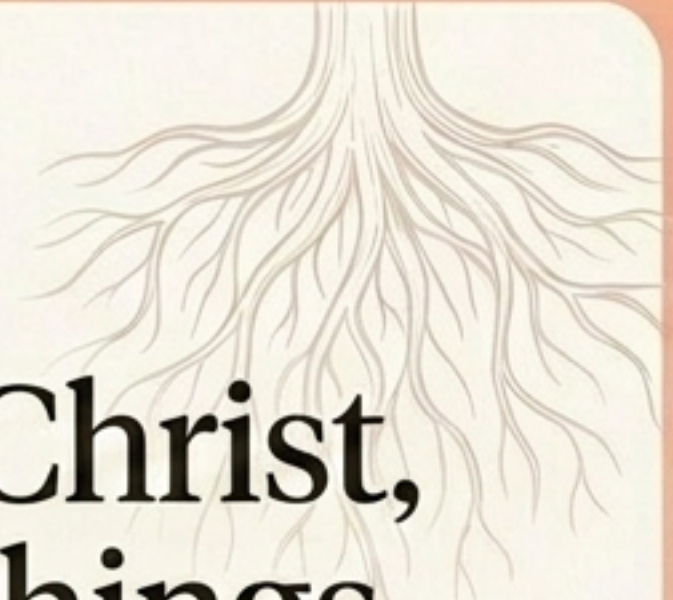
ROOTS — SALVATION & IDENTITY

Prayer & Reflection: God, illuminate the next right step. Give me a hunger to read Your Word so I can walk securely in Your light.

GROWTH — THE WORD

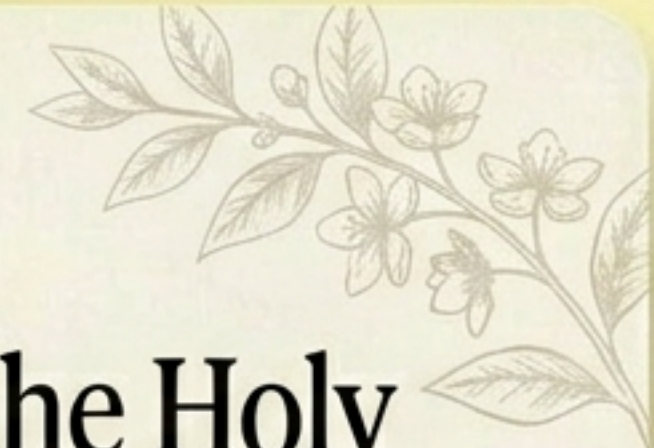


**But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.**

Prayer & Reflection: Heart Check: Lord, grow these specific traits in me today. Where I am impatient, bring longsuffering; where I am harsh, bring gentleness.

POWER – DAILY STRENGTH

**Philippians 4:13 (NKJV)**

Prayer & Reflection: Jesus, I acknowledge my own physical and emotional limits, and I invite Your limitless strength to carry me through this day.

POWER — DAILY STRENGTH

His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.

Lamentations 3:22-23 (NKJV)

**Prayer & Reflection:** Father, I rest in Your unending faithfulness. Thank You for supplying fresh compassion and mercy for every new morning.

HARVEST — THE GREAT COMMISSION



All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 28:18-19 (NKJV)

**Prayer & Reflection:** Lord, I embrace the authority You have given us. Give me the obedience to go out and make disciples in my own community.

HARVEST — COMPASSION FOR THE LOST

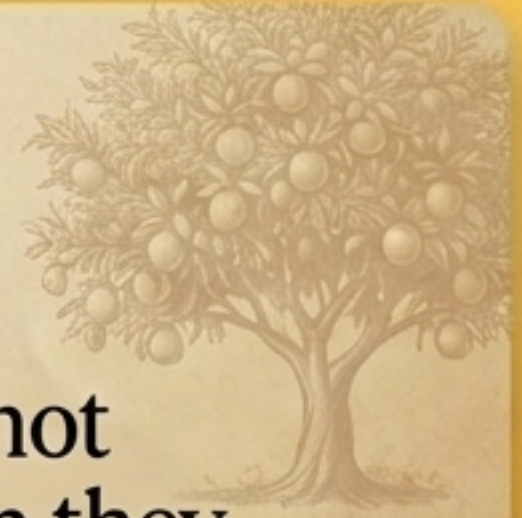


Then He is gracious to him, and says,

HARVEST — OVERCOMING FEAR

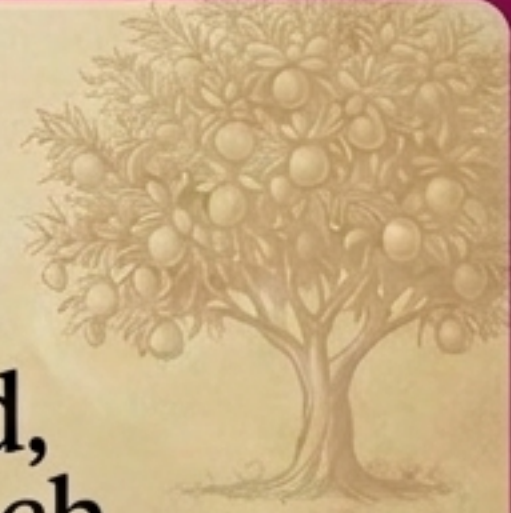


For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.
