Read & Reflect

What similarities and differences do you notice between how each Gospel records this parable?

2. Context & Summary Reflection

In your own words, summarize this parable. What is Jesus teaching about awareness, discernment, and the signs of His coming?

3. Observation

What signs or patterns does Jesus use to illustrate spiritual awareness and preparedness?

4. Interpretation

What does this parable reveal about how believers should interpret the “signs of the times”?

5. Application

How can you remain spiritually alert and discerning without becoming fearful or distracted by worldly noise?

Personal Reflection

6. Self-Examination

Are there areas in your spiritual life where you’ve grown numb or indifferent to Christ’s return? Write them down.

7. Invitation to the Holy Spirit

Ask the Lord to sharpen your spiritual discernment. What is He prompting you to focus on or turn away from?

Challenge of the Week

8. Weekly Challenge

Choose **one way you can live with greater Kingdom focus this week** (e.g., sharing the gospel, renewing your prayer life, studying prophecy, or reconciling with someone). What will you commit to?
