3. Observation

What imagery does Jesus use to describe alertness and readiness?

4. Interpretation

What does this parable reveal about our role as stewards of what God has given us (time, gifts, opportunities)?

5. Application

What would it look like for you to “keep your lamp burning” in your life this week?

 **Personal Reflection**

6. Self-Examination

Are there areas in your life where you’ve grown complacent, distracted, or spiritually sleepy? Write them down honestly.

7. Invitation to the Holy Spirit

Ask the Lord to show you where you need to be more vigilant and faithful. What is He revealing to you?

8. Weekly Challenge

Identify **one way you can live more ready for Christ's return** this week (e.g., restoring a relationship, sharing the gospel, being faithful in your calling). What will it be?
