📖 Read & Reflect

🧠 2. Context & Summary Reflection

Jesus uses this parable to illustrate our calling to shine His light, not hide it. In your own words, summarize what Jesus is teaching through this parable.

3. Observation

What specific imagery (lamps, stands, light, darkness) stands out to you?

4. Interpretation

What does the lamp represent? What does it mean to hide it under a bowl, and what is Jesus teaching us about courage and witness?

5. Application

How can you “place your lamp on a stand” this week? Think about relationships, conversations, and decisions where your faith can shine.

 Personal Reflection

6. Self-Examination

Are there areas where you've been hiding your light—whether out of fear, busyness, or wanting to “blend in”?

7. Invitation to the Holy Spirit

Ask the Lord to reveal where He's calling you to shine more boldly. What is He impressing on your heart?

 Challenge of the Week

8. Weekly Challenge

D.L. Moody said, *“A Christian is the world's Bible—and some will never read the Scriptures except through us. If our light is hidden, how will they ever see Christ?”*

Choose one way to intentionally let your light shine this week (a conversation, an act of service, sharing your faith). What will it be, and how will you stay accountable?
