WHO: You + Your Friends (10-20 people is ideal)



WHAT: Send Roe Your Vote Care Packages to College Students/Friends/Relatives

(1) set up evite with event info and a list of care package items quests can sign up to bring;

(2) prep enough essentials for all guests including packing tape, filler, sharpies, notecards, and boxes (use flat rate boxes from your local post office)



WHERE: Private home (or anywhere)



WHEN: Before September 30th to meet the MO voter registration deadline of October 12th (ship Rosh Hashanah themed boxes by September 19th).



WHY: To give our college students/friends/relatives the knowledge and power to vote, while also providing tools for reproductive health and treats for a sweet new year.

SUGGESTED CARE PACKAGE CONTENTS:

- condoms
- morning after pill (take within 3 days of sex)
- vote stickers (<u>roe, roe, roe your vote</u>)
- Sweet & savory snacks (swedish fish and gold fish roe theme)
- challah/<u>honey</u> /<u>baked apples</u>/<u>freeze dried apples</u>
- Emergen-C

ABSENTEE VOTING IN MO

Are you registered? Check <u>here</u> - deadline to register to vote on Nov 8th is Oct 12th

Absentee ballot requests must be received by October 26th.

Once you have your absentee ballot:

- Absentee voters may vote absentee beginning on Sept 27th
- Ballots must be received by 7 pm on Nov 8th-return by mail or in person
 - Complete the statement on the outside of ballot envelope and sign on the signature line **IN FRONT OF A NOTARY PUBLIC***Notaries available at some banks, UPS/postal parcel stores and on college campuses. Remember to bring a photo ID to show to the notary. Do not mark up return address or any barcodes on the envelope.
- Ballot can be turned in person by a close family member on or before Nov 8th or mail no later than OCT 27th.
 - *unless you are incapacitated or confined due to illness or physical disability on election day, or caring for a person who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or disability and resides at the same address.
