Our Accomplishments

- **Board Retreat & Goal Alignment:** We kicked off the year with a powerful board retreat and team-building session. Our board members reconnected with our vision, set strategic priorities, and committed to ongoing collaboration through newly formed working committees.
- **First Community Town Hall:** We hosted our first Town Hall, a milestone event attended by district leadership, staff, the Rotary Club president, educators, and engaged residents. It was an energizing evening full of shared ideas and community voices.
- **Launched the Empower Dublin Campaign:** We launched our Empower Dublin initiative to fund targeted academic support, enhanced campus safety and cleanliness, and equitable access to STEM programs. The campaign focuses on smaller class sizes, expanded supervision and custodial staffing, and science fair opportunities for all students.



- **Ongoing Community Engagement:** We've held meetings with school principals, Parent Faculty Clubs (PFCs), the Dublin Teachers Association (DTA), Rotary Club members, and other community leaders. These connections are at the heart of our work.
- **Regional Learning and Collaboration:** We attended a Bay Area Foundations Roundtable, joining other education advocates to share best practices and learn how to strengthen our foundation's role locally.
