Welcome friends and families to the My Place SUMMER Newsletter!

It sure has been a hot start to our summer here in the Glen. The kiddos have really been enjoying all the outside water play time, popsicles at the lake, ice cream field trips, and more. Please be sure that you are dressing your children in weather appropriate clothing with extra's available. We also ask that you provide us with your child's sunscreen and/or proper sun protecting clothing to avoid sunburns. With the kiddos going on walks, climbing on the playground and running a lot throughout the day please be mindful of appropriate footwear to avoid any injuries.

The classroom teachers have a lot of fun things planned for the upcoming summer months. With all the fun to be had we will also continue our focus on literacy. Early literacy plays a key role in enabling the kind of early learning experiences that research shows are linked with academic achievement, reduced grade retention, higher graduation rates and enhanced productivity in adult life. Early literacy means helping children develop a rich vocabulary, self expression, and reading comprehension-all tools they need to become successful readers and lifelong learners. It is so important to build vocabulary at an early age and with your help each week we will have these kiddos on the right path for success! Please take note of the weekly vocabulary words listed on the classroom lesson plans. The classrooms will be adding these into their daily conversations and have them around the classroom, we hope that you too can talk at home about these words each day. We also have numerous boxes of books in the vestibule area of our lobby, please feel free to take what you would like. Also, be sure to check out the little free libraries in the parks, My Place will be adding books for community enjoyment and to spread our love of reading!

As always, we are diligently working on active communication with families, please be sure that all of your information is up to date within our ProCare app. It is important that you have an active and working app, to sign your children in and out daily as well as communicate with the classroom staff, Kris, and I. 

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Summer Enrichment Program 2024

The My Place After School Program, which is licensed through the Office of Child and Family Services will be offering a Summer Enrichment Program for ages 4-12. We will be operating Monday-Friday at the Watkins Glen Elementary School from 7am-6pm. We will be accepting limited enrollment for \$258 weekly or \$60 per day. Each additional child per family will receive an 8% tuition discount.
