### **Work Places 2019-nCoV Screening**

#### **Can COVID-19 be transmitted at the workplace?**

COVID-19 spreads primarily through respiratory droplets or contact with contaminated surfaces. Exposure can occur at the workplace, while travelling to work, during work-related travel to an area with local community transmission, as well as on the way to and from the workplace. (WHO)

#### **How can people assess the risk for exposure to COVID-19 in their workplace and plan for preventive measures?**

Jobs or tasks with close contact with people who may be more likely to have COVID-19, as well as contact with **objects and surfaces possibly contaminated with the virus.** (WHO)

#### **What is the risk of contracting COVID-19 in the workplace?**

The risk of exposure to COVID-19 in the workplace depends on the likelihood of coming within 1 metre of others, in having frequent physical contact with people who may be infected with COVID-19, and through **contact with contaminated surfaces and objects.**

## **Ask What We Can Do For You**

We can take swabs at critical contact surfaces from Hospitals, Universities, Banks, Offices and other public place and provide data on **Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome coronavirus 2** presence.
