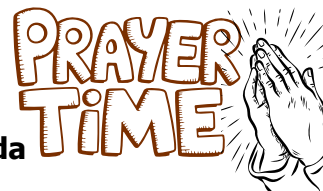

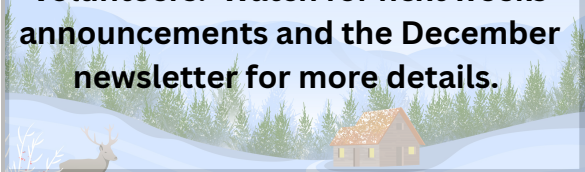
Thank you for helping us meet our \$30,000 District Support goal! We kindly ask you to pause those donations and resume again in January.
