- A. Scholarship funds must be used within two years of graduation from High School. In special circumstances this may be extended by Fair Management.
- **B.** We must receive a copy of your registration before payment can be made. ½ of your scholarship is awarded the first semester and ½ the second semester. (You must provide a copy of your registration for the second semester to receive the second payment.)
- C. You must remain a full-time student. (12 units minimum) to receive your scholarship.
- **D.** All correspondence relating to your scholarship must be sent to the Fairgrounds office.
- E. You must participate in all scheduled Ambassador activities which may include, but are not limited to: Helping to construct and riding in a float for the 2025 Christmas Parade; Devising a game show or other presentation which provides information about the fair, and presenting it to local community clubs; Assisting with clerking for the Poultry, Rabbit, Horse and Livestock Shows; Judging the Barn Duty award at Fair.
- **F.** As a fair ambassador, you serve as a representative of the Colorado Fair to the local community. As a result, the CRF may request progress reports to monitor a participant's grades during their tenure. In addition, attendance and participation in all listed events are required. If there is a concern that a prior or ongoing commitment may create a conflict if you are selected to be a Fair Ambassador, please disclose at the time of your interview and explain how you will minimize or mitigate this impact.

H. You must conduct yourself as an Ambassador from the time of award through Fair 2026. You may not use Alcohol or Drugs. You may not smoke at any time in any place while fulfilling your duties. You must always keep in mind that you are a role model. Expulsion from or Suspension from school may terminate your Scholarship.
