

CRJLB LIVESTOCK AUCTION

1. The sale shall be limited to one of the following: One market beef, swine, lamb, goat, or feeder calf. Sale is further limited to only Livestock Exhibitors 9 years and over as of January 1, 2022, who have met all requirements of sale who reside fulltime within the 54th District. Livestock Exhibitors will be assumed by entry to be selling. **IF NOT**, must declare his/her intent **NOT** to sell by 4:00 PM on **Thursday, March 17, 2022**.

Livestock exhibitors (Market animals only), will be allowed to sell at the CRJLB Livestock Auction if they meet the following requirements: (A) Limited to a single entry. (B) **ALL** Exhibitors selling at auction must turn in a completed record book to group leaders. (C) YQCA training and qualification completion.
2. Four percent (4%) shrink will be used for the sale.
3. Large animal Livestock Exhibitors **MUST** participate in Showmanship in order to sell at the Auction.
4. Exhibitors must be in the dress code specified above.
5. Those livestock exhibitors selling their animals at the CRJLB Livestock Auction must turn in an addressed, stamped Thank You note. **THANK YOU NOTES MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE LIVESTOCK OFFICE BY 10:00 AM SUNDAY, MARCH 20, 2022**. No ribbons, awards or checks will be issued if not turned in. NAME OF SELLER AND RETURN ADDRESS MUST BE ON ENVELOPE.
6. Seven percent (7%) will be withheld from the seller's proceeds for the CRJLB Livestock Contingency Fund. The Funds are under the control of, and managed by the Colorado River Junior Livestock Boosters they have final approval before any funds are expended. The fund covers the loss of animals during the Livestock Show, at current market value and the improvements in the livestock related areas. An exhibitor fee (Stall Fee) will also be charged for **ALL WEIGHED IN** animals. This fee is \$25.00 for rabbits and poultry, \$50.00 for swine, sheep, feeder calf, goat, sheep and \$85.00 for steer. These fees will go to the Colorado River Fair for use of the facilities. Swine must also pay a .45% of gross sale fee to the National Pork Council. Lambs must pay ½ cent per pound and .30 cents per head to the National Lamb Council.
7. It is the policy of the CRJLB that dollars raised as a result of donating back animals for re-auction must be for a scholarship fund available to high school graduating senior livestock exhibitors only, the barn fund and/or other pre-approved Livestock related activities
8. All donated back animals will be auctioned only after completion of the printed sale list. If any animal is donated back, the original buyer may not avail themselves of base, slaughter or self pick-up options.
9. The Scholarship Fund and Barn fund will be maintained by the Colorado River Livestock Boosters.
10. **ALL CHAMPIONS AND RESERVE CHAMPIONS must sell at auction unless: (a) the exhibitor is not qualified to sell in which case the Judge shall choose a "Sale Champion". Or (b) the exhibitor has a large animal AND a small animal Champion in which case the exhibitor may choose to sell either the Small Animal Champion or the large animal.**
11. Only those animals which are judged to be market acceptable will be allowed to sell.
12. NO "For Sale" signs may be placed in the pens or barn area.
13. **Animals shall not be painted with any substance. No foreign material of any sort shall be placed on any part of their bodies at any time while on the Fairgrounds, including glitter or any type of spray paint.**
