Rules:

- Must have approved yellow slip or brand inspection paper.
 - Animals must be male and meet breed color characteristics.
 - Calves must be Holstein type and show their respective breed characteristics.
 - Holstein Calves Breed Characteristics: Holstein Breed color characteristics must be as fallows; Black and White marking clearly defined, color markings which will NOT be acceptable are solid black, black in switch, black belly, black encircling leg touching hoof, black from hoof to knee/hock, black and white intermixed to give color other than distinct black and white, no black baldies or reds. Holstein breed character is defined as follows; angularity of body and legs, withers- sharp, neck- long and lean, clear cutthroat, dewlap and brisket, ribs- wide, flat and long, thighs- incurving to flat when viewed from the side.
- Animals must be castrated and dehorned.
- Animals must not be over 125 days of age at the time of weigh-in as verified by Bill of Sale.
- Calves are required to be milk fed; however, they must be weaned 30 days prior to the Livestock Show.
- Minimum weight 250lbs Maximum weight 375 lbs.
- Animal must be owned by exhibitor by January 16, 2023 and must have been TAGGED by that date.

MARKET SCORECARD

<u>Group 1:</u> Animals are smooth, deep, thick and compact; and the udder or scrotum shows a marked fullness. They must have youthful appearance and be in good condition.

<u>Group 2</u>: Animals must possess a moderately high degree of the higher quality grade characteristics. They will carry less finish, show more bone, and have less uniformity.

Group 3: Animals lack finish, are rather leggy and hippy, are rough in the shoulder, and are light in the round.
