At the Colorado River Fair, there is nothing more important than the safety of our guests and staff. This is our highest priority now and always.


As we continue to monitor developments surrounding the Coronavirus, we want to provide you with an update. Effective Thursday, March 12th in accordance with a recommendation from public health officials that large public gatherings be canceled or postponed to help slow the spread of the COVID-19, the 54th District Agricultural Association Colorado River Fair, is canceling their 2020 Annual Fair event, which was scheduled to open on Thursday March 12, and run through Sunday March 15. This cancellation includes the livestock show, carnival rides, and scheduled entertainment. We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause the community and look forward to greeting you, next year at the fair.

The California Department of Public Health finds the following events be postponed or cancelled through the month of March.

1. Large gathering that include 2050 people or more.
2. Smaller gatherings held in venues that do not allow social distancing of six feet per person.
3. Gatherings of individuals who are higher risk for severe illness from COVID – 19.

Management is diligently working on a refund policy. In about two weeks, check our web site for further instructions and information.
