FAQs

What is a Junior Firefighter?

Junior Firefighters are 14–18 year old members who have the opportunity to learn valuable life skills while providing an essential service to their community and provide support during fire calls.

Who should consider becoming a Junior FF?

The fire company has a diverse group of members who come a variety of backgrounds and professions. The majority of our members started out as Junior Firefighters and have gone on to become leaders of our fire company.

What is the time commitment?

It's up to you! In addition to responding to calls for service, when available, the fire company holds training every Monday 7:00pm – 8:30pm.

Is it Safe?

Junior Firefighters can participate in our regular trainings under supervision. Governed by state law and fire company policies, Junior Firefighters are limited in what they can do on the scene. For instance, they are not allowed inside of a burning building or on a highway at the scene of a crash.

What are the requirements?

Like most school activities, all Junior Firefighters are required to maintain at least a C grade point average. They must also receive a medical clearance, obtain their Act 153 background checks, and receive consent from a parent or guardian.
