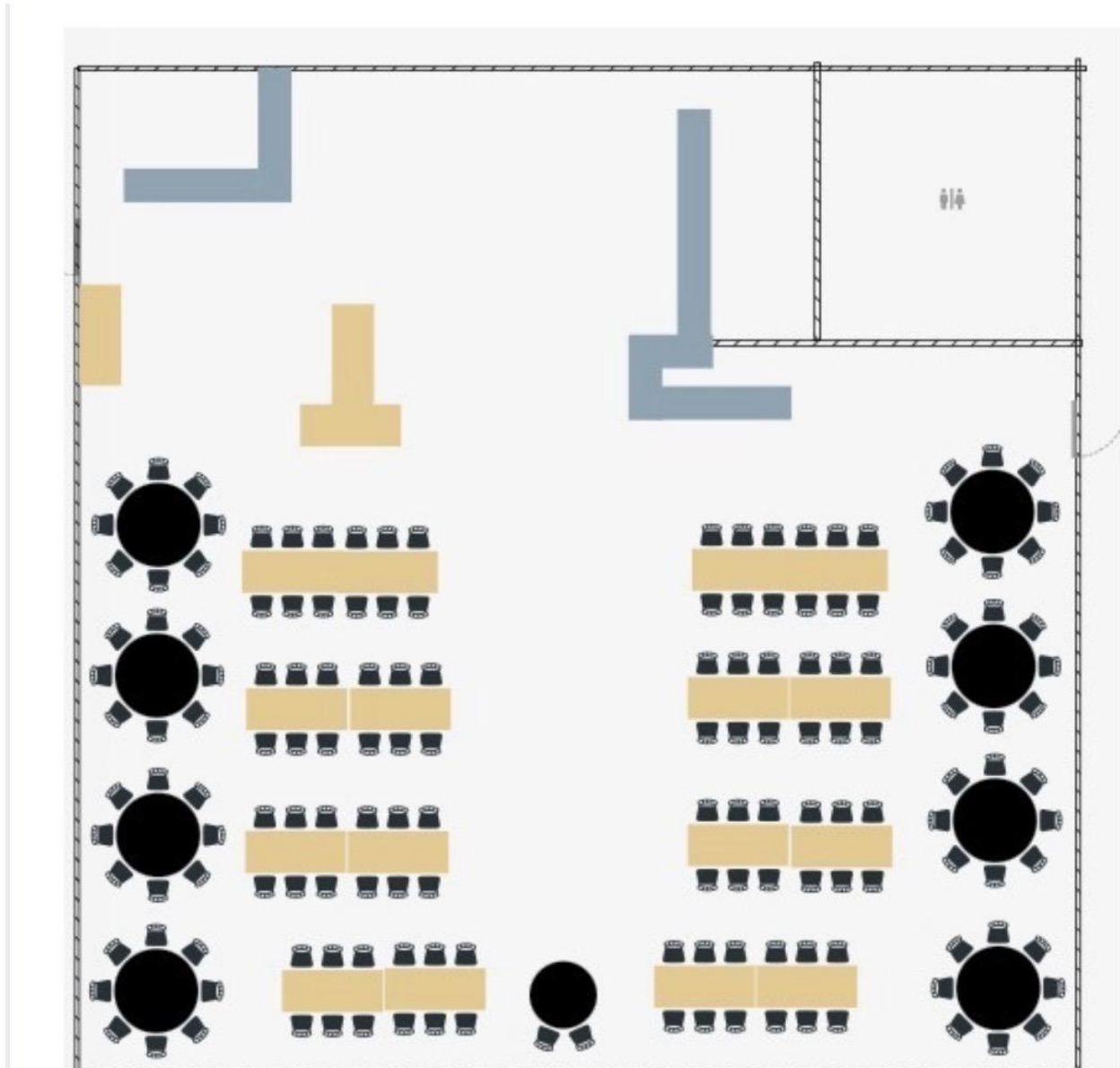

BEVERAGES

Lemonade, ice tea, sweet tea, water, and ice will be available all night to guests. An open bar will be available from 4 PM - 10:30 PM for all guests over 21 years of age.

Beer- We will supply a variety of beer options in both cans and bottles. We stock fan favorites such as Michelob Ultra, Busch Light, Snapper IPA, Blue Moon/ Boulevard Wheat, Seltzers in a variety of flavors.

Wine- We will supply one red wine blend, one sweeter white wine (example: Moscato), and one dryer variety of white wine (example Sauvignon Blanc).

We do not serve or allow any liquor, champagne, champagne toasts, speciality drinks, or shots.

SERVICES

Event Coordinator- Provided by Glenn Acres Farm

- 30 days prior to your wedding date you will have a sit down meeting at Glenn Acres Farm with Katie to go over final details, guest count, and to pay your final balance due.
- Event Coordinator/Katie will coordinate your ceremony rehearsal on Friday night at 5:30 PM if your ceremony is at Glenn Acres Farm. Rehearsal generally lasts 45 minutes.
- Event Coordinator/Katie will coordinate your wedding day including but not limited to: all set-up, arrival of all vendors, staff coordinations, wedding processional line-up and timing, cocktail hour charcuterie, reception dinner, cake cutting, announcements, and all other scheduled events.

Staff & Bartender

- One bartender from 4 PM - 10:30 PM
- 2-4 Catering staff members will assist for the entire event for set-up, clean-up, reception dinner coordination, and any other services needed for the wedding. The number of staff members is dependent on the number of guests needing to be served.

All Set-up & Clean-up

- The event center will be cleaned, tables set with plates and silverware, and ready for decorations by 1 PM on the Friday before the wedding.
- All chairs will be set up on Friday for the ceremony if the ceremony is being held in the White Barn.
- Staff will continuously clean from 4 PM - 10:30 PM on Saturday to keep the venue looking nice.
- All decorations that you bring will be returned to the containers that you brought them in by 10:30 PM if you would like to take them home on Saturday night.
- Any leftover food will be delivered up to the farmhouse kitchen.
- The wedding cake topper will be saved in a cake box for the bride and groom to take home.

Amenities

- White plates, charcuterie table plates, cake plates, paper dinner napkins, paper cocktail napkins & cake napkins, silverware, Mason jar drinking glasses, wine glasses provided.
- Wood tables, round tables, 8' & 6' folding tables, cream resin cross back reception chairs, white plastic folding ceremony chairs are provided

ADDITIONAL SERVICES INCLUDED IN WEDDING PACKAGE

Use of Venue Decorations

- 2 faux eucalyptus runners per table, tall glass tealight holders, white tealights, tall glass vases with silk white rose bouquet, gold and white table number sign
- Round Tables (60", 8 tables) cream or black spandex linens, round wood centerpieces, cream ceramic vase, silk white rose bouquet, glass tealight holder with gold base, white tealight, gold and white table number sign
- Indoor Ceremony (built-in cedar wood ceremony arbor, 8' & 6' cedar wood Crosses)
- 8 large silk white roses and eucalyptus flower arrangements for wood posts, 20 silk white rose and eucalyptus chair ties for the aisle, 2 small silk white rose and eucalyptus arrangements for the Crosses, white chiffon drapes, large silk white rose and eucalyptus arrangement for arbor
- Outdoor Ceremony (wood cedar ceremony arbor) use of the indoor ceremony decoration depending on weather conditions. Crosses and some arrangements will not work in high wind situations.
- **Memorial Table** we have an antique shelf that we like to use, a small sign that says "I know you would be here today if Heaven weren't so far away", and a candle.
