- Planning Pod software is included and offers a personalized website that collects your RSVPs & includes many more planning tools.



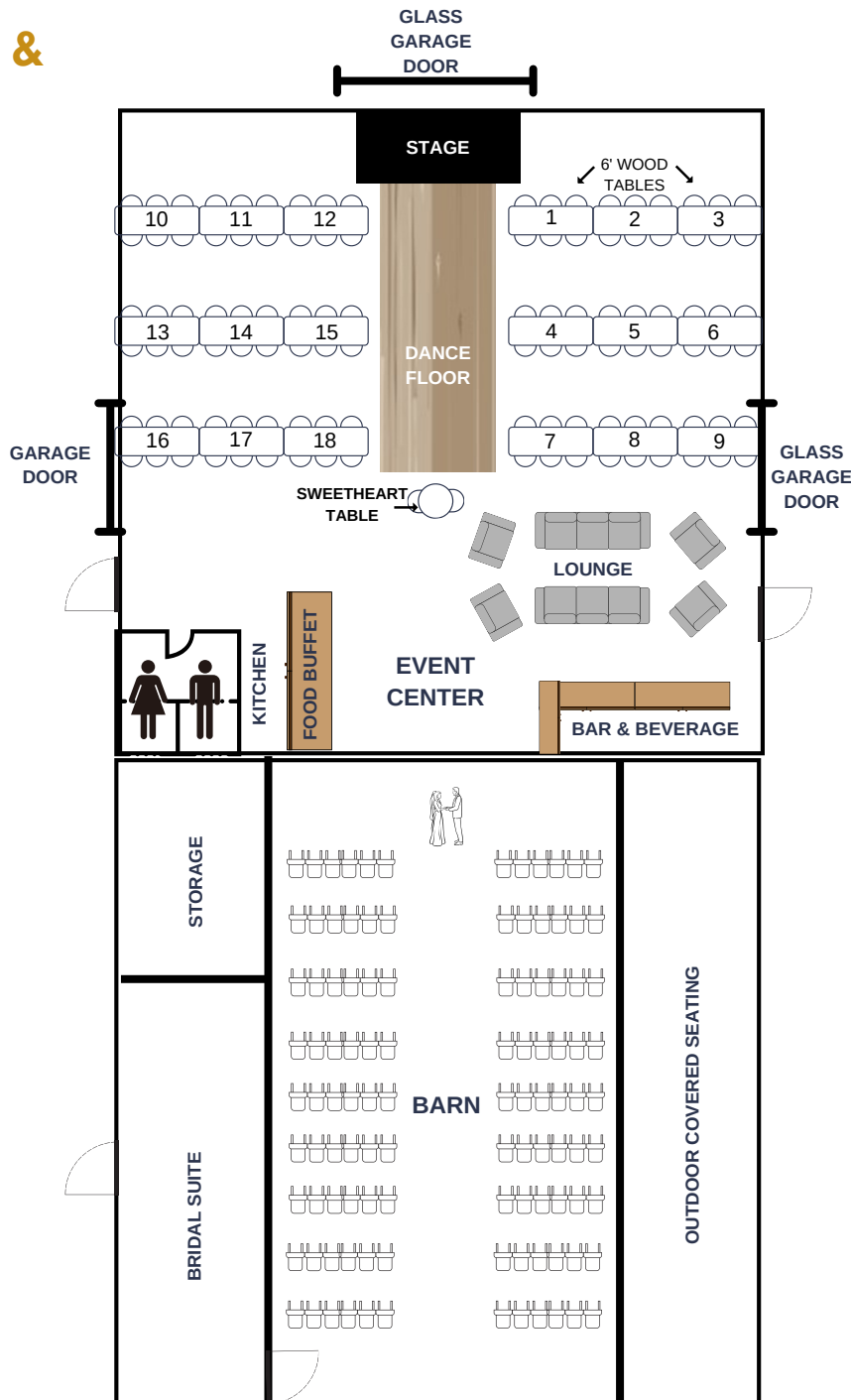
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## NOT Included:

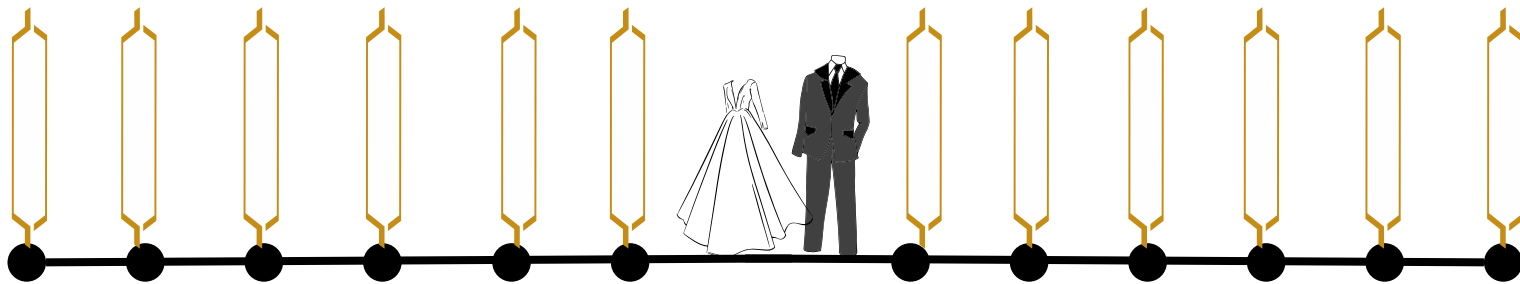
