

WHEREAS, the Grant Parish Police Jury does hereby declare that the use of Kratom is a serious problem affecting the health and welfare of all citizens. The Grant Parish Police Jury does further declare and determine that all reasonable steps should be taken to prohibit the sale of Kratom in Grant Parish;

WHEREAS, the Grant Parish Police Jury hereby deems it necessary and proper for good government, order and protection of persons and property, and for the preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the Parish and its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Parish Police Jury have concluded that to protect the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana, the possession of Kratom should be incorporated as a municipal misdemeanor crime within the Parish of Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Grant Parish Police Jury of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana in regular session convened, as follows: to wit:

Section 1. It shall be illegal for any person to possess Mitragyna Speciosa Korth (Kratom) in the Parish of Grant.

Section 2. Penalties.

- (1) On a first conviction, wherein the offender possesses Kratom in violation of the provisions of Section 1 shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both.
- (2) On a second conviction, wherein the offender possesses Kratom in violation of the provisions of Section 1 shall be fined one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both.

(3) On a third or subsequent offense conviction, wherein the offender possesses Kratom in violation of the provisions of Section 1 shall be fined one thousand, five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both.

Section 3. If any provision or item of this Ordinance or the application thereof is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or application, and to this end the provisions or items of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable.

Date of Enactment – This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon <u>approval and</u> adoption by the Grant Parish Police Jury.
