

The Shooting Range Board of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana, met in special session at its meeting place, the Multipurpose Educational Center, 1142 Landfill Road, Dry Prong, Louisiana, on Thursday, May 7, 2026 at 3:00 p.m.

Julian Garcia called the meeting to order and opened the agenda to public comment. No comments were brought forth.

Motion by Mr. Dale Whitstine, seconded by Mr. Josh Daniels to accept the minutes of the last meeting as published on the web page. Motion carried unanimously.

Board members discussed the following general business
New membership prices were established effective June 1, 2026

All children 11 years old and under can shoot at no charge / Supervising adult must pay daily rate or have annual membership

- Everyone 12 years old and older will be charged \$10.00 per person per day to utilize the Pistol/Rifle ranges or will require an annual membership

Annual Membership Prices

- There is a \$25.00 discount for law enforcement and military on all adult annual memberships
- Children 12 years and older are \$65.00 each if purchased with an adult annual member

Pistol/Rifle Range Annual Memberships

- \$100.00 per year per person
- \$200.00 per year per couple
- \$165.00 per year for 1 adult and 1 child 12 and over
- \$265.00 per year per family

Skeet Field Annual Memberships (Includes Pistol & Rifle)

- \$200.00 per year per person
- \$300.00 per year per couple
- \$365.00 per year per family

Daily Usage Fees (No annual membership)

- \$25.00 entry fee per person per day + \$15.00 per box of shells shot (must furnish your own shells)
- Entry fee waived for annual members. \$15.00 per box of shells shot (must furnish your own shells)

4-H Members – January of each year through state competition

- \$10.00 per box of shells shot (must furnish your own shells) for current 4-H members
 - All shoots must be accompanied by RSO or 4-H coach for 4-H events

Members discussed prices for metal targets. It was decided to continue the research and possibly hold future competitions to pay for a couple of metal targets.

Mr. Julian Garcia advised the board that the Grant Parish Shooting Club would be holding a competition in June with categories for varying levels of shooting experience.

Motion by Mr. Julian Garcia, seconded by Mr. Josh Daniels to nominate Mr. Dale Whitstine as Committee Chairman. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Mr. Josh Daniels, seconded by Mr. Jack Brown to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
