### PROCLAMATION 09-2026

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance Disaster Act, R.S. 29:721, et seq. confers upon the Parish President the authority to deal with emergencies and disaster in order to ensure that preparations of this parish will be adequate to deal with such emergencies or disasters and to preserve the lives and property of the people of Grant Parish; and,

**WHEREAS**, Grant Parish Police Jury issued Proclamation 05-2026 issued February 27, 20256 issuing a parish wide burn ban; and,


**WHEREAS**, upon reviewing the most recent data from the National Weather Service and the Office of State Fire Marshal; and

**WHEREAS**, conditions have improved in Grant Parish due to the rain and moisture in the area; and

**THEREFORE**, the Grant Parish Police Jury does hereby order the Burn Ban issued by the Grant Parish Police Jury on February 27, 2026 is hereby rescinded.

**HOWEVER**, we ask residents to exercise caution and discretion when they burn as conditions may quickly change.


