The following resolution was offered by Mr. Brandon DuBois and
seconded by Mr. Johnny Jamison:

RESOLUTION 12-2024

A resolution approving the holding of an election in Fire District No. Seven of Grant Parish, Louisiana, on Saturday, December 7, 2024, to authorize the renewal of a special tax therein.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Fire District No. Seven of Grant Parish, Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Fire District No. Seven of Grant Parish, Louisiana (the "District"), adopted a resolution on July 11, 2024, calling a special election in the District on Saturday, December 7, 2024, to authorize the renewal of a special tax therein; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the District has requested that this Police Jury, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to continue to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Police Jury to approve the holding of said election and in the event that the election carries, to continue to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Fire District No. Seven of Grant Parish, Louisiana, this Police Jury hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, December 7, 2024, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

FIRE DISTRICT NO. SEVEN PROPOSITION (RENEWAL)

Shall Fire District No. Seven of Grant Parish, Louisiana (the "District") continue to levy a special tax of 15 mills (the "Tax") on all property subject to taxation in the District (an estimated \$27,600 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for a period of 10 years, beginning with the year 2025 and ending with the year 2034, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, operating and maintaining the fire protection facilities of the District, including all necessary equipment, provided that a portion of the Tax proceeds is required to be contributed to state and statewide retirement systems as provided in R.S. 11:82?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, this Police Jury does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to continue to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein.

This resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:


