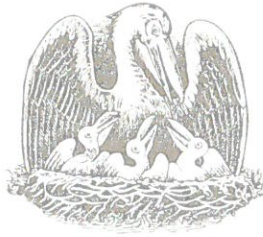

PROCLAMATION

03-2020

WHEREAS, there is an ongoing public health emergency due to COVID-19 presenting a threat to the people of Grant Parish, said emergency being recognized in Executive Order 30 JBE 2020, GPPJ Proclamation No. 2020-001, and

WHEREAS, the parish wide elected officials located in the courthouse have taken steps to modify their operation, all the while keeping their offices open to serve the public, and at the same time protecting the health and safety of both the public and the employees that serve them, and doing their part in curtailing the spread of COVID-19,

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED THAT:

- 1) It is in the public interest that admittance of individuals to the Courthouse should be limited, and avoided if at all possible
- 2) All business should be conducted by telephone, email, fax transmission or mail, if at all possible,
- 3) Any person who desires to conduct in person business at the courthouse should first call the appropriate office to schedule a visit, if at all possible.
- 4) No one shall be admitted to the courthouse 1) who is ill or exhibiting any symptoms of CORVID-19, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, 2) who has been exposed to someone in the last 14 days who has been diagnosed with or is exhibiting symptoms of CORVID-19.
- 5) We all will strive to work together and work with the public to get through this trying time, all the while serving the needs of the public. We ask that the public do their part in helping us.
