 - -hang signs with hours and fees throughout the parish
- -members will look into having steel targets donated
- -the Board agreed to purchase paper targets and sell them for \$2.00 each to recover the purchase cost
- -Secretary/Treasurer will check the legalities of purchasing and selling ammunition
- -hold events where patrons are allowed to test fire a range of firearms for a fee
- -members agreed to the possibility of obtaining a card reader for patrons in lieu of cash
- -members agreed to allow the schools in Grant Parish to utilize the range for their Hunter's Safety Courses as they are covered by their own insurance and will have their own instructor
- Mr. Dale Whitstine will look into teaching a Hunter's Safety Course in January of 2026 -the entrance gate has proven to be a bit narrow for larger vehicles so a new gate is being donated and installed at no charge
