Sissy Pace called the meeting to order and opened the agenda to public comment. No comments were brought forth.

Motion by Mr. Josh Daniels, seconded by Mr. Carlos Butts to accept the minutes of the last meeting as published on the web page. Motion carried unanimously.

Board members discussed the following general business

- Skeet Field prices – Mr. Dale Whitstine will call and get comparable prices to discuss at the Special May Meeting
- Members discussed developing an archery field. Will get regulations regarding berm height and area needed
- Members approved unanimously to allow State Troopers to utilize the pistol/rifle side of the complex for qualifying purposes on Tuesdays or Wednesdays at no cost. Any other day will be a charge just like the public
- Members discussed a possible grant but determined it did not meet our capabilities
- New membership prices were established effective June 1, 2026
  - o All children 11 years old and under can shoot at no charge / Supervising adult must pay daily rate or have annual membership
  - o Everyone 12 years old and older will be charged \$10.00 per person per day or will require an annual membership
  
  - o Pistol/Rifle Ranges Only
    - \$100.00 per year per person (discounts for law enforcement and military)
    - \$200.00 per year per couple
    - \$265.00 per year per family with children 12 and over
  
  - o Full Complex Charges
    - \$200.00 per year per person
    - \$300.00 per year per couple
    - \$365.00 per year per family with children 12 and over
