

The Shooting Range Board of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana, met in regular session at its meeting place, the Multipurpose Educational Center, 1142 Landfill Road, Dry Prong, Louisiana, on Monday, March 2, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.

Mr. Julian Garcia called the meeting to order and opened the agenda to public comment on agenda items.

Motion by Mr. Carlos Butts, seconded by Mr. Josh Daniels to accept the minutes of the last meeting as published on the official site. Motion carried unanimously.

Chief Nathan LaCombe, Creola Police Department, addressed the board regarding municipal police departments utilizing the shooting complex for their training and qualifying each year. All board members agreed that they could schedule through the Sheriff's Office for Wednesday practice or schedule in advance for a Tuesday practice once Chief LaCombe's certifications and insurance have been received.

Mr. Jason Innis was unavailable to discuss expectations of the 4-H Pistol Shooting Team to pick up spent shell casings, but Mr. Carlos Butts advised the board that he would be a point of contact for any issues pertaining to the matter.

Mrs. Hallee Parker updated the board regarding the Skeet & Scholars Classic fundraising event.

Board members reviewed and discussed property boundaries according to the official survey. The tree line and thirty-five (35) feet beyond bordering the Judy Box property is actual Police Jury property contrary to what Mr. Roy Danzy had previously stated. The tree line and sixty-seven (67) feet beyond on the side that borders the Ora Baxley property is also Police Jury property.

Board members reviewed the financial statements.

Skeet field uses and fees will be determined at a later date. The rules will include not allowing any shot size smaller than 7.5 and 1 1/8 load shot amount.

Board members agreed that one more Conex is needed for the skeet field. The donation documents were reviewed and approved by all members. Mr. Josh Daniels will discuss with the donor and Mr. Julian Garcia will execute the documents.

Types of competitions for the grand opening will be discussed and finalized at the April meeting.

Due to the cost of an armor guard, the item has been dismissed.

Motion by Mr. Josh Daniels, seconded by Mr. Jack Brown to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
