

The Shooting Range Board of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana, met in regular session at its meeting place, the Multipurpose Educational Center, 1142 Landfill Road, Dry Prong, Louisiana, on Monday, November 3, 2025 at 5:00 p.m.

Mr. Julian Garcia opened the meeting to public comment on agenda items.

Motion by Mr. Dale Whitstine, seconded by Mr. Josh Daniels to accept the minutes of the last meeting as published on the official site. Motion carried unanimously.

Board members thanked Mr. Steven Blaylock of Pro Fence Unlimited LLC for his generous donation of labor by installing the fence and gate around the pistol and rifle ranges. It has not only added to the security of the complex, but enhanced it visually as well.

Mr. Dale Whitstine discussed RSOs giving instruction for civilians, 4-H students, GPSO Deputies, or Grant Parish Municipal Police Officers during closed to the public hours. All agreed to the following:

- No charge for Grant Parish 4-H youth members, Grant Parish Sheriff's Officers, and Grant Parish Municipal Police Officers
- All other Sheriff's Offices must pay the normal daily rate
- RSO's are allowed at no charge, but all guests other than those listed above must pay the daily rate or have an annual membership

Members discussed where to place the flagpole for the American Flag being donated by Woodmen. They agreed that it should be seen from all over the complex and it would be located near the educational center with lighting.

Mr. Josh Daniels discussed having access to digital billboards and will be able to run ads at no cost to the complex.

Members discussed requesting the DOTD to place signs at the end of Landfill Road on Hwy 122 and Hwy 167. All agreed to have the secretary submit a request to the DOTD.

Mr. Michael Bolen, President of the Student Chapter of Central Louisiana, spoke to the Board regarding utilizing the facility for a fundraising skeet shoot event. April 18, 2026 was selected as the date and the Board will discuss details at the December meeting.

Members discussed the best place to install the "Range Hot" flag and all agreed that the inside of the gate would be the best and most visible place.

Motion by Mr. Josh Daniels, seconded by Mr. Carlos Butts to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
