WHEREAS, in 1992, the Grant Parish Police Jury received a grant to construct water system improvements to the Town of Colfax water distribution system in the unincorporated community of Grant Parish known as "The Rock"; and,

WHEREAS, the subject parcel described above was acquired by the Grant Parish Police Jury in 1992 for the purposes of constructing a water booster pump station in the 1992 Water System Improvements Project; and,
