

The Grant Parish Police Jury is eager to return to our normal routine of serving our constituents throughout Grant Parish. On Monday, May 18th, all Grant Parish Courthouse offices will be open to the public under the state guidelines. We want to assure you that we are continuing to adhere to all federal guidelines and are prioritizing community health and safety as we reopen our offices.

While we are excited to serve our parish again, we must also continue to practice appropriate social distancing procedures and follow safety guidelines from the state and federal government and the CDC. We are all in this together, and we are committed to keeping our community and employees safe. Below are the additional steps we are taking to prioritize community safety as we reopen our offices.

**Upon arrival, all citizens will be required to adhere to the following protocols prior to entering the courthouse:**

- . An employee will screen you with a series of questions before you enter.**
- . Your temperature will be taken before you enter.**
- . All citizens will be required to wear a mask when inside the building.**
- . We ask that you make an appointment as we are limiting the number of citizens to no more than 10 at a time allowed in the courthouse. Anyone accompanying a minor or a citizen with a disability, please call ahead for guidelines.**
- . Social distancing measures will remain in place in all areas of the courthouse.**
- . If you feel sick or have been exposed to someone with COVID19, we ask that you reschedule your appointment or court date with the appropriate office.**
