

WHEREAS, our community wishes to express its sorrow for the passing of Mr. L.R. "Pop" Hataway on Tuesday, June 22, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Mr. L.R. "Pop" Hataway was the longest serving Sheriff in the history of Grant Parish, having served eight terms and was a Deputy Sheriff for nine years prior to being elected; and

WHEREAS, beginning in 1976 he served as the Grant Parish Sheriff for over 32 years, was a former president of the Louisiana Sheriff's Association and a former vice president of the Red River Delta Law Enforcement Planning Council in Pineville, Louisiana. He has served on the Louisiana Highway Board, the Drug Control and Violent Crime Policy Board, and the U.S. Penitentiary Community Relations Board. He graduated from the Federal Bureau of Investigation Academy in Quantico, Virginia, the National Sheriff's Institute in Los Angeles, the Louisiana State University Law Enforcement Institute in Baton Rouge, and the Interrogation School of the University of Oklahoma in Norman, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mr. L.R. "Pop" Hataway earned the respect, admiration, and high regard of all with whom he came into contact and our community has sustained a great loss in his death:
