

Questions for the Shoe Game

This can be a fun and lively addition to the early part of your reception, either before dinner or before dancing. Here's how it works...

The bride and groom sit in chairs that are placed back to back. So they can't look at one another. Both take off their shoes before the game begins, and each gives one of them to the other person. The game begins with an emcee or announcer asking the first question. The groom and the bride then decide which person fits the answer.

For example...If I ask "Who's the better kisser?" The groom and the bride each answers the question by raising the shoe of the person they think is the best.

- 2 Who was the cutest baby?
- 3 Who is smarter?
- 4 Who mentioned marriage first?
- 5 Who says I'm sorry first after an argument?
- 6 Who has the smelliest feet?
- 7 Who looks better in glasses?
- 8 Who is the better driver?
- 9 Who is better at keeping secrets?
- 10 Who spends more money?
- 11 Who is going to pay the bills?
- 12 Who has the craziest family?
- 13 If you were trapped on a desert island, who would be more likely to eat the other one to stay alive? (optional question)
- 14 Who gives better presents?
- 15 Who talks more?
- 16 Who is more likely to get lost?
- 17 Who is likely to ask for directions?
- 18 Who is messier?
- 19 Who starts the arguments?
- 20 Who will be doing the cooking?
- 21 Who is always right?
- 22 Who did more of the wedding planning?
- 23 Who owns the most pair of sunglasses?
- 24 Who is the better kisser?
- 25 Who do you love most in the world?
