

Dave MonnierSecurity Evangelist & Fellow at Team Cymru

Mr. Monnier is a recognized voice in the security community. He began his career performing UNIX and Linux administration in academic and high performance computing environments where he helped build some of the most powerful computational systems of their day. Subsequent to systems administration, he moved into Internet security, having served as a lead security engineer for Indiana University and later helped to launch the Research and Education Networking ISAC, part of the formal U.S. ISAC community. Mr. Chin experienced his first DDoS attack (for ransom) in 2003 and has lived them with them daily ever since. He has experience with in-house infrastructure (e.g. - Riverhead, load balancers, big Internet pipes, reverse proxies, CDN), but as attacks became more frequent, bigger in scale, and more sophisticated (e.g.- targeted application layer attacks), he turned to the mitigation services of dedicated providers such as Prolexic to provide ongoing protection and mitigation.
