• Passport - Required

If you are interested in coming on a mission trip and either do not have a passport or your passport is not valid for at least 6 months after we return, please **apply for your passport ASAP**, **as it takes much longer now**. **You need your passport to apply for your Visa. Apply today!**

- <u>Visa</u>: Required for Tanzania We will obtain online ahead of time –I will send you directions and the answers to the questions you will need to answer (probably in January) once tickets are purchased.
- MFH is requiring all participants to be fully vaccinated for COVID. Other necessary vaccinations are listed below.
- Register at US Embassy Smart Traveler Program
 - o **Tanzania Level 2** (Level 1 is life is perfect)
 - o United Arab Emirates (Dubai) Level 2 -Threat of missel and drone attacks

Tanzania Mission trip

Dates: Thursday, July 3, 2025– Saturday, July 19, 2025

<u>Cost:</u> as of 9/23/24 the cost of the flight is \$1872.70 which includes three 50lbs bags free, choose your own seat at no additional charge, and an overnight in Dubai each direction, and dinner and breakfast at the hotel in Dubai. Price is subject to change until the flight is booked.

The flight on July 3rd leaves Boston at 11:05pm and we arrive home on Sunday July 19th at 2:10pm.

There is an overnight in Dubai going in each direction. On our way to Tanzania we arrive in Dubai about 7:30pm which is plenty early for you to go out and see Dubai (either on a tour or on your own). On our return we do not get into Dubai till 9:50pm so that doesn't really give you time for sightseeing.

Where we stay

We will be staying at the Mbagala Center in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, which we have stayed at many times before, and travel each day (about 2 hours) from the Center to the village we will be working at that day. The center is very simple, but clean and safe. You can stay in a single, double or triple depending on how many people are traveling with you. Each room has its own bathroom with a toilet, sink and shower. For the most part the rooms only have cold water although they do supply a bucket so you can get hot water from the sink at the end of each hall. There are a couple of rooms with hot water. We eat breakfast and dinner at the Mbagala Center. **At lunch time we are out in the villages, so each person brings from home protein bars etc., whatever they want to eat for lunch.** We will purchase cases of bottled water when we get there for each person so you will always have plenty of fresh water to drink.

When is money Due?

To give you an idea of what is due when moneywise.....

- Flights must be paid upfront....
- Safari will require a 50% deposit when booked (about December) & the balance in May.....
- Room, Board, etc. expenses will be due in May

Additional Information

Medical - Vaccinations/Medications for Tanzania

You should all have the following medications/vaccinations before your trip to Tanzania. Some of these you have already had as part of normal life, but check to be sure they are current.

- 1. Hepatitis A
- 2. Hepatitis B
- 3. Polio Booster
- 4. Tetanus (good for 10 years)
- 5. All Covid Vaccines
- 6. Typhoid
 - Typhoid Vaccine live oral Ty21a (VIVOTIF) capsule- Take 1 capsule by mouth every other day for 4 doses. Take 1 hour before a meal., Disp: 4 capsule Good to take this at least a month before the trip. Good for 5 years. A shot is also available, but that is only effective for two years.

7. Malaria Medication

• **Atovaquone-proguanil HCl 250-100 MG** per tablet, Take 1 tablet by mouth daily starting day 1 before trip to 7 days after.

8. Not necessary, but good to have for Travelers Diarrhea
Ciprofloxacin (CIPRO) 500 MG tablet, Take 1 tablet (500 mg total) by mouth 2 (two)

times a day, Disp: 8 tablet

Check with your insurance to see what is covered where. I used GOOD RX and saved a lot of money on those that were not covered by insurance

Clothing – Modest dress

- See recommended list of items to bring
- You may have clothes washed while you are there.
- Women (and usually men) do not wear shorts in public.
- Spray clothes????

Communication

- Internet available most times
- cell phones services check with your provider- usually available

<u>Currency</u> – Tanzanian Shillings 2,736 Tz Shillings = \$1.00 (as of 10/5/24) (fluctuates a lot)

- Only New Style Money, American dollars are accepted in Tanzania. NO TEARS OR RIPS
- You receive a better rate of exchange if you exchange large (\$100's, 50's) bills.

Current - 220V

- You need a 3 prong plug (UK size) Adaptor.
- You need a current converter if the items you will be charging don't state that they work on both currents.
- A 220 V power strip is great if you have a lot to plug in. Can purchase online.
