Subject: QuadAir Spring Cleaning

Does the inside of your QuadAir Table look like this?

With a busy season fast approaching now is a great time to clean up and clean out your QuadAir table!



Spring Clean Up

- 1. Polish the playfield with *Puck Sweat* weekly to ensure fast and smooth game play. Do not use any sharp instruments on any part of the machine as it may cause irreparable damage.
 - Puck Sweat Table Polish Part 3704009 IN STOCK
- 2. Vacuum the inside cavity of your QuadAir table. Dust, grime, and other debris can collect inside the body of your table over time. This is the perfect opportunity to vacuum out this inside cavity and the blower intake. Note: **NEVER ATTEMPT** to clean the interior while the game is operating.
 - Please give special attention to the gear in the goal assembly, it may begin jamming over time
 - The easiest way to access the inside of the table is through the puck drop chute doors and the blower compartment door underneath the table
 - Remove the goals and clear any dust and debris; this is where most debris will enter and these areas should be cleaned thoroughly to ensure that everything functions properly.
- 3. Use a non-ammonia non-bleach household cleanser to wipe down the poles, side panels, and legs.

- 4. Clean any dirt or debris from the main PC Board with a soft brush or dry cloth. **NEVER USE WATER OR OTHER LIQUIDS.** Always be sure to turn off / unplug the machine before opening the PCB panel.
- 5. Stock up on pucks and mallets for the upcoming busy months!
