We remain concerned

Let me get this straight: The original application for a Special Use Permit for an 80-unit RV Park at the already congested area around Torch River Bridge was denied by the Milton Township Planning Commission on July 11, 2021. The downstate developer is appealing that decision, but meanwhile, he has submitted a new plan for a 70-unit RV Park. Does this new plan really meet the ordinance violations that resulted in the Milton Township Planning Commission denying the first one?

I find it hard to imagine that reducing the size of the RV Park by this amount (from 800 possible unit owners and guests to 700) will now make it environmentally safe, solve the public safety issues, return the Green Belt of mature trees, maintain the character of this small community, and reduce the outrage among those of us who live in the vicinity.
