The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) requires all public transit operators to provide special service to persons whose disabilities prevent them from using fully accessible public transit. The special service, called "ADA paratransit service," operates at similar times and in similar areas as existing non-commute (off-peak), fixed-route transit.

You will not be allowed to board without proper fare.

- One-way fare for any County Connection LINK trip is \$4.00. Exact fare is required for each one-way trip drivers do not make change.
- Eligible personal care attendants ride free.
- A companion is required to pay the \$4.00 one-way fare.
