WHEN ANGELS MAKE DECISIONS Part 2

I pray all of you had a wonderful Christmas and holiday season. I didn't make Part Two of the topic "When Angels Make Decisions" a Christmas issue because this is for the whole nation— and it won't be based on the holidays. I love the Christmas story and how angels are so involved with it. The foundations of Christianity are both the Easter and Christmas stories. Without those events we don't have Christianity, and angelic involvement accompanies each story. Frankly, we could go back even further throughout the Old Testament to see how important angelic involvement is in the history of mankind. But I wanted us to understand the everyday involvement of angels in our lives. We will be needing all the angels we can ask the Holy Spirit for. I pray things will go peacefully for this second Trump Administration, but I'm not exactly hearing that as I pray.

In fact, let me state up front that I believe February through July will be tumultuous. We will stabilize from July to November. I think it will take until November for total normalcy to return. Now, we as citizens may know nothing of what goes on behind the scenes within our security apparatus of what may be happening. But, I do believe eventually we will be successful and the nation will be saved. There will be quite a few events which must be overcome. And the Lord has assured me we can and must ask for angelic help; as both citizens, and in our own personal lives.

Prayer Needs

We have a great resource in prayer. While America has four major enemies, her secret weapon is answered prayer. This is what put Trump back in the White House. China, Russia, Iran and North Korea don't want to give up their exalted places of terror and thievery in the world.

The Lord has not told me to stop praying to avert war. He started that thread in prayer in 2022. Our intercessors have been praying to avert war since then. I'm also hearing from the Lord that our enemy wants to use terrorism through war with those four foreign sources— and nations aligned with them. He wants to use Islamic attack; and chaotic protests like we saw with Palestinian supporters, as was done last year.

Unfortunately, we saw first hand on 1/1/25, how satan desires to inspire Islamic forces to attack the citizenry. As we remove criminal and other illegal immigrants, they may resist expulsion from the country. Sadly, we even see political influences as a source of protest or chaotic events. Even though one side may lose an election, they have become very adept at wreaking havoc inside the government; never realizing the damage caused when the country does not move forward because of fractured unity. We need to pray for Trump, Vance, and cabinet members in charge of these issues, as well as their families, along with other governmental officials in charge of making America safe as well as prosperous.

I also have an unction to pray for the protection of financial districts, their critical structures and the people and elements involved in maintaining them. We also pray concerning the safety of the internet as part of everyday life, along with its part in our critical infrastructure as a nation. Cyber attacks have gotten out of control. I'd venture to say almost every major institution in our nation has been hacked, along with the information associated with them. We have major commercial strikes being threatened. I'll make no comment one way or the other as to the validity of the strikes, but some of these labor-union strikes can make a mess of our supply chain operations. Our energy grids like electric, gas, etc., should also remain a topic for prayer. There is one last issue to pray to stop, and it has to do with catastrophic natural events. Let's each pray in our own respective states, and around the nation for protection from fires and other disastrous events.

Let me state unequivocally that prayer can avert all of these problems and even if they do happen, prayer can help all of us overcome their effects. I am convinced that none of these things need to happen if we pray. It was a miracle Trump lived through two assassination attempts. It is a miracle he was re-elected. All of this was because God answered prayer. We need to continue to pray. The extension of this word from October is to highlight the help we will have in the spiritual realm. I want to be clear about what this word/teaching is and what it is not.

The Nature of This Word

First, this isn't a teaching on angels. We could look at the five divisions of angels; we could look at the when and why angels are sent. There are many subjects we could explore from the Bible concerning angels. Instead, what I felt led to do here was focus our attention to this word of help for America. The Lord is letting us know that the Angel in charge of America is at work and will work for the saints and God's plan for the nation. We are tasked with prayer, and prayer concerning the subjects I just highlighted.

Let me give those of you who may not have read the October 2024 word, a reminder. The scripture I had been given was Exodus 23:20-33. It is the first time in the Bible that we see an angel given responsibility over a nation. That nation was Israel. From this scripture we are told of principles we can expect when an angel is given charge over a nation. The Lord told me plainly that He will release the Angel over America to help us during this time period and that we can expect angelic help when we ask for it. I'm advising you to pray and ask for that help. The Lord has released me to share an experience I had many years ago with the Angel in charge of America. First, let's print out the scripture so you can read it. Then, we will review the scriptural parameters surrounding this word.

Exodus 23:20-33: "Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name is in him. But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries. For mine Angel shall

go before thee, and bring thee in unto the Amorites, and the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Canaanites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites: and I will cut them off. Thou shalt not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do after their works: but thou shalt utterly overthrow them, and quite break down their images. And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfill. I will send my fear before thee, and will destroy all the people to whom thou shalt come, and I will make all thine enemies turn their backs unto thee. And I will send hornets before thee, which shall drive out the Hivite, the Canaanite, and the Hittite, from before thee. I will not drive them out from before thee in one year; lest the land become desolate, and the beast of the field multiply against thee. By little and little I will drive them out from before thee, until thou be increased, and inherit the land. And I will set thy bounds from the Red sea even unto the sea of the Philistines, and from the desert unto the river: for I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand; and thou shalt drive them out before thee. Thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor with their gods. They shall not dwell in thy land, lest they make thee sin against me: for if thou serve their gods, it will surely be a snare unto thee."

First-Mention Principle

The above scripture is and was for Israel. In the first part of this word, printed in October 2024, I made it clear that God has not left Israel and the Angel over America is not the same as the Angel over Israel today. Israel has her own angel, and God has graciously granted America her own in our timeline as well. It would seem from other passages in the Bible that angels are sent over other countries as well.

As Bible college students, we are taught many things concerning the Bible. While I'm not entirely sure all Bible colleges still teach about the First-Mention Principle, I do know many still do. It is usually part of the study of hermeneutics. This principle teaches the reality that whenever we see a topic first mentioned in the Bible, it relates the governing

interpretation for that principle any time it is mentioned in the scriptures thereafter. In other words, you can't make up assumptions concerning that event. You must go back to the first time you see it occur or mentioned so you can interpret it correctly the next time you see it occur or mentioned.

Unpacking the Principles From Exodus 23

One: The pattern followed by God in the foundation of Israel tracked with God performing miraculous events, and instituting laws laid down by Him to take care of the nation, which her people were to follow.

Two: Decisions made by humans for the Israelites were approved by God (Exodus 18:13-24), and God added other items He wanted seen done (Exodus 19:3-24). The people gathered together and agreed, thereby making a covenant with God. These covenants are binding and quite serious (Exodus 19:25-23:19). It seems clear throughout all these passages that disobeying carried God's wrath (Exodus 22:22-24).

Three: Just like the previous two items, this one has a long-term need. In other words, we can look to the other two items and see if another nation formed by God carries a similar pattern. That pattern is that all angelic involvement points towards Christ. In the case of the Angel over Israel, he is protecting the nation itself to bring forth Jesus. In Israel's case, if Israel did not exist in the future, Jesus could not have come forth from a Jewish virgin. As it was back then, so it is today: Israel is surrounded by enemies wishing for her extinction. Christ's Second Coming cannot take place if that nation is gone. This angel in Exodus protects the life of the nation to ensure the birth of Jesus, His Second Coming and the generations of Israelis that would come thereafter. Angelic involvement always fulfills a purpose of/for and about Jesus Christ.

Four: The events or atmosphere which surrounded the necessitating of angelic decision-making had to do with the Israelites, or the nation itself.

As a people, they were being rebellious thus endangering the whole nation. A large majority were not following the instructions given by God and understood by the nation at its founding. It is obvious that not every single Israeli was resisting God's desired leadership, but a majority were affecting the nation as a whole.

In fact, let me expound upon that because it's a constant reality throughout the Bible. Whenever God's words and ways are denied, His presence is removed. He does not strive with man's sin. We see this here in Exodus as the first time God removes his presence from the nation, but sends the governing angel over the nation to take care of them. The Lord warns them not to mess— my words— with this angel because he won't be as tolerant of them as the Lord has been. The consequence of this event was God being faithful to His people by appointing this angel over the nation to lead and guide them. It is the sin of a nation that necessitates the withdrawal of God's presence.

It is also a time period when God sends His prophets to correct a flailing ship. There are those who say miracles, prophetic words and the baptism of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking with other tongues is not for today because we have the New Testament and there is no need for prophecy or miracles like there was in the early church and the Old Testament because we can all hear God's word. It is their belief that because of Jesus' sacrifice we can all go to the source ourselves, where they could not do so in the Old Testament. So because we can all go to God's word, we should all know from God about prophetic happenings and we can all get miracles. That argument presupposes people with no sin. It presupposes that all people will believe, obey and never resist God.

Let me ask a question: Do all churches believe and follow the will of God? We have churches in America that appoint homosexual priests over their congregations. They support and "marry" homosexual couples. They encourage transgenderism. There are churches who support abortion in all events. In other words, they don't believe that exceptions for the life of the mother or exceptions for rape or incest need

to exist because abortion for any reason should be sanctioned. There are churches more interested in fame and fortune than doing God's will. How many churches today actively disciple their congregations in the things of God, the Bible and the Holy Spirit? There are those churches who vehemently deny the gifts of the Holy Spirit— even denying His outward manifestation among the congregation. So lawlessness can reign in those congregations.

These conditions make them apostate and in rebellion to the God of the Bible. In fact, if you ask saints in the persecuted churches overseas, many will tell you that the American church is, in fact, apostate. I would agree, except I don't believe every single church in America is apostate. There are many doing God's will, teaching and discipling God's people and leading others to Christ. Nevertheless, if the early church needed signs and wonders, along with the baptism of the Holy Spirit, we need Him more so today. As long as we have apostate churches in America, Europe and elsewhere, we will need those true prophetic voices God sends and we will need the corroboration of those voices with signs and wonders following.

Continuing the List of Principles

Five: God intervened when Israel was threatened and He intervened in this situation in Exodus as well. This was not something dreamed up by the human mind or the leadership inaugurated by God. This was a decision made by God Himself to send the angel, and not mankind.

Six: We know this decision was made not just for the Israelites. It seems earlier in Exodus that the continued striving of the Israelites against God's commands has, shall we say, annoyed our Lord enough to make Him fed up with their nonsense. He says as much to them in our passage: "Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name is in him." Because of Israel's sin, if the Lord remained with Israel as His presence had before, the flesh of Israeli mankind could not have continued to exist in this

atmosphere of holiness. The Lord wanted Israel to exist to bless other nations and the planet as well. This action was as much for Israel as it was for the rest of us.

Seven: Another item we see in all angelic visitations is danger: Whenever angels show up, they are there to stop or protect someone or a group from experiencing some type of potentially dangerous situation.

Eight: We've discussed events that Israel would need to accomplish in the future. But there is another all encompassing understanding, and we see it in the first sentence of our passage: "Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared." This angel was to help them follow God's commandments and laws and those would in turn bring them to the land that God was giving them. Countries occupy land, and these angels help the countries inhabit that land mass. They are there to stop their neighbors and other foreign adversaries from stealing the land God gave them.

Parallels for America in Items One Through Eight

Do we see other nationally associated spiritual beings in the Bible? Yes, we do. While the angels mentioned by name— Gabriel and Michael—are associated with Israel, we do see where angels had to fight with other spiritual beings associated with other countries (Daniel 10:13, 20-21; Ezekiel 28). We could assume by these verses that these were not Godly spiritual beings, but those associated with our enemy. We do know from scripture that Lucifer, who became satan because of his rebellion against God, was an angelic being created by God. He willfully sinned and lost his God-given name Lucifer, becoming what he is now named, satan. And for those of you who don't regularly read any books or articles I have written, I do not capitalize the name satan. Grammatically I should. But I have decided he does not need his name capitalized. This is a personal decision and one I am not suggesting others follow. The choice is yours.

In Daniel 9:9-19, we see how long Israel has sinned. Daniel stands as both a prophet and intercessor for the nation. An angel appears at the end of his prayer. Gabriel is sent to give Daniel understanding and to share or write what the angel tells him so the nation understands what is coming. This understanding even extends to our time period. In America we see constant sin, even among those who claim Christianity. The Lord has raised up true saints, pastors, prophets, evangelists and many others to preach and warn the nation. Many of us have seen angels. I will share more about that later.

In *Items One* through *Three*, the Lord had me write a book proving our nation was founded by God and that He gave us our laws. That book also proved our covenant on this land with Jesus as Christians. It's a 698-page book.¹ Other authors have written books concerning George Washington, the miraculous ways he escaped death and his everyday religious habits. Obviously, we were founded as a Christian nation. That means we covenanted with God in the furtherance of the gospel.

Item Four looks at how a nation sins. You really don't need a footnote or a source to confirm that item when it comes to America. If you do, just click the Archives link and read any number of articles. I'm sure you will be able to find footnoted criminal and evil events committed that I've had to document.

In *Items Five* and *Six* we see God helping America when she does not deserve the help, and we see how America has blessed the world. Money flows from her to many foreign nations. In fact, so much money that I think every citizen would rise up in protest if we knew the exact amount.

Item Seven does not need one footnote. I watch a news station which talks about the deception and theft China has enacted upon the U.S. and her businesses. Greed from these corporations has kept us vulnerable to

the danger from all the foreign actors aligned with China. Many think we can fight our way out of a war. Sure, with one adversary; but, we have many that have come over our borders, sending exceptionally dangerous groups and teams of people. We may not realize this, but we are in desperate need as a nation for the Lord's help, even through angelic assistance.

Item Eight is also, unfortunately, a no brainer. In the case of America, we have been blessed to go in an opposite direction of our founding than Israel because we were established in a covenant with Jesus. As the colonies were settled over many years, a few of the kings who sent them from England documented their goals. One was to expand the gospel; but in all cases there was two sides to this coin. The second item in their goals was to expand their economic fortunes. Our early founders were quite religious. I've documented that also in the book, "70 Years of American Captivity: The Polity of God, The Birth of a Nation and The Betrayal of Government." Staying on the pathway laid out in the Bible was a very real goal for our early American ancestors. It was not hard for them. Any honest historian looking into settlers circa 1520 through 1820, could see how religious families were. Church attendance was a regular occurrence for most.

Taking over our land back then was attempted many times. Nevertheless, all attempts failed. The Angel of the Lord over America did not have a hard time helping us keep our land. But now, in real time, before our very eyes, we have immigrants, foreign actors from various countries, socialists and communists within our land and government all attempting to steal our land right from under us. Please view the footnotes from the last article to see the proof. My question is, why is that? Could it be because our citizens have forsaken the God who placed Christians on a new land in order to found a new nation? We are coming to the tipping point.

There is an international section of Washington, DC, where other nations have offices to petition and lobby our government. Their influence is not benign, but has become quite malignant over time. With all the illegals in our nation, as well as foreign actors controlling parts of the Capitol which control major parts of our national enterprise, is it any wonder that we need the Angel over America and Christians who follow and disciple according to biblical instruction?

A Personal Experience

Many years ago the Lord gave me an experience but did not allow me to share it publicly. I have been allowed to share it with some of our intercessors and obviously my husband the next day. But I've never been released to share it in a public forum. This is my first time. It was around the 9/11/01 timeframe, possibly months or a year or so after. We were members of a church with some national importance. I did not do much of significance in the church. I was not in leadership at all. I helped with some children's events; sang very briefly as a choir member; spent a short time with other church members tasked as a group to pray for people after the church services if leadership called folks to the altar for prayer; and, helped out one of the ladies in charge of the women's prison ministry. During that period of time, which was roughly three and a half years, I also helped the pastor of a different church's local soup kitchen. Along with my other duties, there wasn't a lot of time to spare for anything else except for two voluntary actions that Jesus asked me to do.

I was not part of any intercessory group within the church, except as all attendees during events or during various meetings. I share this material so you have an understanding as to why Jesus allowed this experience to take place. This specific week during the church's calendar entailed national prayer warriors and other national ministers of some kind coming for the events. This church had so many of them that I'm not exactly able to remember the specifics of the events, except what I have already shared.

I do remember coming home late one Friday night during this specific week of meetings for America. I hope my memory is correct on the days, but that would make the next night a Saturday. The church usually did not hold meetings on Saturdays. So it was either a special Saturday meeting or it was a Sunday meeting, I can't remember which now. A prayer warrior of some fame was to preach. Friday night meetings usually involved ministers of national importance preaching. I do not remember which one did so that particular Friday night, but the next meeting, whenever that was, this intercessor was scheduled to preach.

What I can say with a certainty is as I approached the gates, I got out to unlock them and was shocked and somewhat frightened to my core. Standing before me as I approached the lock was an angel that I can tell you had to be hundreds of feet tall, possibly more. I could only come up to maybe his ankles. I could not tell you what he looked like from the waist up specifically. That's because his height was so immense that all I could see with my eyes were his feet and somewhat up his calves to what in my spirit I understood as a Roman-type uniformed skirt; the kind their soldiers wore thousands of years ago.

Also in my spirit I knew that he had a drawn sword in his hand. I could see the lower part of it. I understood immediately that he was the Angel in charge of America. I wasn't afraid in the natural sense of the word, but I was somewhat frightened in a spiritual sense. You might ask why I didn't look up or ask any questions. Well, first, he was wearing a Roman soldiers' skirted uniform. If I looked up from where I was standing, I would be looking somewhat up the skirt and I didn't think that was appropriate.

Next, if he decided to take a step, I would have been crushed. Thirdly, I needed to unlock the gates, open them and get back in the car. I had to drive in between his legs. Now, they were spread out approximately twenty or more feet. But if he decided to take a step, my car offered no protection either. It would have been crushed, along with me. All I could do was pray. I just kept praying, over and over: "Jesus, oh Jesus please don't let him take a step, please protect me." I repeated that prayer

consistently because I had to stop, park the car, get back out, walk to the gates, close and lock them, walk back to my car, get in and drive to the house.

The sword was not drawn to strike me, but I was taking no chances. Prayer was my only thought. I can't remember now whether he had a helmet on— maybe he did, maybe he didn't, but for some reason I think he may have, although, like I said, I didn't look up. I've never seen an angel that big and frankly, I was shaking in my boots— and I mean that figuratively. I doubt I had on boots that night. The thought occurred to me that my house was no source of protection either. But I made it in the house and just kept asking the Lord what was going on. He gave me no answers— those were to come the next night.

I actually pretended like I had not seen him, although I knew Jesus knew I did and if that was the case, so did this angel. I didn't even think to ask him any questions. I mean, what was I going to do; shout up into the sky? I had seen angels before and very rarely do they speak to me except that I usually know what they are showing me or why they are there without saying a word.

On one occasion an angel stopped by years after this occurrence and asked me to pray for the pastor of this church. Now, as I said before, the Lord asked me regularly to pray for this church and its pastor without sending an angel. Me and my husband have experiences with angels quite a few times in a year. One of our intercessors had an angel make a request during a troubling time in America. When we compared notes we discovered that not but mere minutes before, the same angel came right into my office telling me that he had come for my words in prayer. I share this to say I don't have long conversations with angels.

I was taught classical Pentecostal theology. We are taught to converse with the Holy Spirit, Jesus or Father God. My experiences in those conversations is constant. But angels, not so much; so that is probably why I don't speak with them and they don't regularly speak with me. It is not uncommon for me to have experiences with angels, it's just not

something I look for. Hearing from the Holy Spirit, Jesus or The Father are my bread and butter. That is something I live for. In any event, I fell asleep that Friday night praying, as you can imagine.

When my husband and I see angels over the course of a year, there is always a purpose for their appearances. I realize there are ministers out there who have every single day experiences with angels, but I am not one of them. So when I say the next night in the meeting when the intercessor guest speaker shared a story of her experience with an angel while flying to our city, I was listening— as they say— on the edge of my seat. The Lord was gracious in allowing her to share it because it confirmed everything I experienced the night before.

I can't remember whether she flew in just prior to the meeting or she was sharing her experience from the day before. As she was flying in, getting ready to descend, she saw what she claimed was the Angel of the Lord in charge of America. She said she saw his head—upper body—from her seat in the airplane as she looked out the window. Again, I can't remember whether her angelic experience was tied to her message that night, but the whole event that week was tied to prayer for America and words concerning America.

From my memory, I do not believe it was the same appearance as I had. For one, I came to my gates at approximately 11:30 p.m., or midnight that night. She seemed to be able to see him quite well, as if the heavens had more sunshine than at eleven or twelve midnight. Next, the flight patterns during that period in time always came over our property. They've changed somewhat now, but back then there were only two times; they were early morning with the last flights flying in before dark. Both flights would place her in the daylight hours. So my experience and hers were at two different times, yet she described what I saw and knew. I don't remember her talking about any clothing or Roman uniform—and I don't think she did—though this many years later I can't be exactly sure if she did mention them.

As a personal note, it was approximately ten years or so later that the Lord commanded me to write the "70 Years of American Captivity" book.³ I always prayed consistently for our nation anyway. But writing a book was not on my calendar, and yet, the Lord was quite insistent. Trust me that you don't say no when He asks you to do whatever it is He asks you to do. It took me about four years to write, and one year for editing. The final edition was published in 2017. This is why I believe this present word to be accurate and true. I base that belief on scripture and my experiences, and the experience of another minister, which also follows scripture. All of this confirms to me that this word the Lord gave me about praying at this time and asking for help from angels, especially the Angel over America, is actionable.

Prayer

Jesus prayed consistently and was successful always. The Lord has promised us answers when we pray. Prayer is the key to overcoming all situations. We're praying for the success of our new president. These include overcoming many antagonistic nations. China, Russia, North Korea, Iran and their surrogate countries that they use for the benefit of themselves, must be overcome. On our own soil we have immigrant antagonizers who may resist going back to their own countries. So we pray for those whom our president has appointed to carry out the task of removing the illegals in America.

Next, the protesters for Hamas and other terrorists have to be arrested. They made a mess of college campuses. These cannot succeed in causing chaos. An American-born Islamic terrorist tried to inflict a great wound on the nation on New Years. Let's pray that these terrorists, whether native born or foreign be exposed for capture to the authorities who can arrest them. In association with this, let's not forget to pray for the peace of Jerusalem. Let's pray the Abraham Accords go forward to success. After all, Iran, through Hamas did what they did to Israel on

October 7, 2023, to make sure the Abraham Accords would not be successful.

We also have many soldiers in our own ranks that are hurting and can become time bombs against the nation. They need help and they need it quickly. The soldier who exploded a CyberTruck outside of the Trump Casino in Las Vegas was hurting. We need to pray for our troops, whether active duty or retired. While I'm on that subject, we need to pray that our president maintains only those connections that the Holy Spirit blesses. Let's pray that those who are in his circle for improper reasons are exposed and removed or disconnected to information.

Our technology and other assets are being stolen at an alarming rate. It has got to stop and prayer can be made to our Father to put an end to this thievery. And lastly, this has always been quite emotional for me and it has to do with natural catastrophic events. In many areas of the country, these are always the source for trouble. Here are some scriptures for your perusal as you pray. I've written out Exodus 23 already in this article. I will say Daniel 8-10 were also critical for this word, and studied extensively. So if you desire, pick up your favorite Bible and read those chapters as well.

Lastly, be blessed and know for sure that Jesus loves you. If you have never asked Him into your heart, there is no time like the present. If you believe in your heart and confess with your mouth that God raised Jesus from the dead, the Bible says you will be saved (Romans 10:9-10). Ask Him into your heart and confess your desire for Him to save and help you. He will do it. Pick up a Bible and start reading from the New Testament.
