

Understanding Animals: Discovering Behaviour, Care, and Connection

Animal Roles in the Ecosystem

Objective:

Understand the role of animals in the environment and their interactions with humans.

Age Group: Key Stage 2 Duration: 1.5 hours

Links to National Curriculum:

- Science: Describe how animals depend on each other and their environment (food chains, habitats).
- Geography: Learn about the local area and how land use supports animal life.

Activity Plan:

1. Exploration (20 minutes):

 Visit the animals in their habitats. Discuss their role in the ecosystem (e.g., cows and milk, pigs and composting).

2. Group Discussion (30 minutes):

- Create simple food chains including the animals.
- Discuss how humans interact with these animals and benefit from their presence.

3. Hands-On Task (40 minutes):

• Help with a simple caretaking activity, such as feeding or observing animal behaviour to understand their needs.

Outcome Across All Key Stages:

- Pupils develop empathy, respect, and understanding of animals and their roles in ecosystems and society.
- Activities foster observation, critical thinking, and responsible action towards animal welfare and sustainability.
