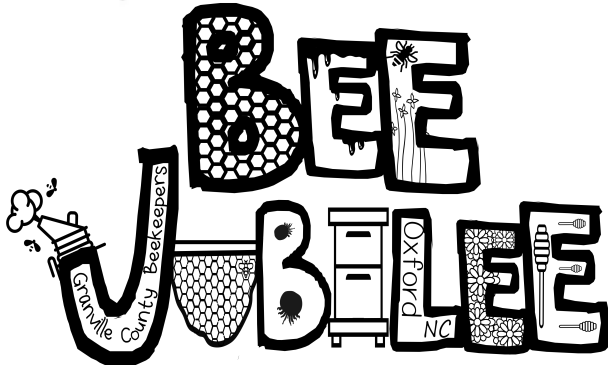

COVID:

- At this time (4/26/21) the use of the Granville Expo Center is still technically not confirmed. We do have all an outside back up location reserved if we need it. We are confident that mandates will loosen soon and the event will continue as usual, with some small changes:
 - Practice all recommended COVID precautions – masks, social distancing, etc... Vendors must provide hand sanitizer at their booths.
 - Less inside activities: No speakers this year, instead we will be showing bee related movies and documentaries. No honey tasting. Fewer inside vendors- We are not opening up inside vendor spaces until June. Reserve an outside spot with the option to upgrade.
 - LIVE outside bee themed AUCTION! And the favorite silent auction inside. Note: LIVE AUCTION items must be values at least \$50. Other donations will be for the silent auction. Vendor donations \$50+ will include a 15 sec description and vendor promotion.

NEW THIS YEAR: This N That, downtown Oxford is allowing use of display windows for Bee & Pollinator themed items for Bee Jubilee Vendors to display and sell at 30% commission. A great way to promote YOU and the Bee Jubilee!!

What can I expect?

- Semi-Juried event: Vendors will be selected based on the following qualities: home grown, hand-made, local, bee related, educational, originality and high product quality. We will credit payments if you are not selected. We will limit multiple vendors of similar craft as needed.
- Vendors are asked to please consider donating an item for the Silent or Live Auction. Bee themed or other appreciated! Proceeds support the GCBA and its continued support of Granville County's pollinators. GCBA is a 501(c)3 organization. Donations count towards sponsorship. - This is a rain or shine event. Deposits will only be refunded if you are not selected for the event.

Information for Bee Jubilee Day:

- Set-up will be Friday night June 25th from 4-8PM and Saturday June 26th at 7AM. Check in info will be e-mailed the week before. Exhibitors must have their space ready by 8:45AM. Drop off times in the arena will be assigned this year.
- Spaces still vacant at 8:30AM will be redistributed to surrounding vendors.
- Please follow parking/traffic signs & attendants. Vendor parking plan will be e-mailed the week before.
- The Bee Jubilee will be open to the public starting at 9AM and booths shall remain set-up until 3pm.
- Booths must be closed and spaces vacant by 7PM.

- Inside vendors will be provided one 3x6 rectangle table and 2 chairs. Inside space is very limited, not available to book until June 1st.
- Outside vendors are responsible for tent/shelter, tables, chairs, etc... We will be making use of the livestock arena behind the building. This is a large covered area and use of it will provide a cooler and safer vendor and attendee experience. Electricity is available, but limited. Please bring an extension cord, +/- power strip. The arena ground is part concrete and part gravel- we will assign spots in June. Most vendors will NOT be on concrete. You can use your tent or go without.
- Food trucks and trailer type vendors will likely be in the front parking lot.
- UPDATE: The Arena layout will be changed from last year. Hopefully a big improvement on traffic flow to all vendors.**

- Vendors selling goods are responsible for their own NC Sales Tax collection. Follow NC DOR Sales & Use Tax requirements.
- Vendors assume all liability arising from the sale or use of their products, displays and equipment.
- Food vendors must contact Christi Henthorn separately. Food vendors must meet all State of North Carolina and Granville County rules, regulations, and licensing guidelines.
- Electricity and running water are available for some outside spaces. Please contact coordinator for more information.
- Displays are to be family friendly. Participation of any and all exhibits, companies, or persons is at the discretion of the Festival organizers. The Festival is a family event for all ages and open to the public. Do not bring items that may cause harm to children, live animals, the environment, or weapons of any kind.
- Vendor cancellations need to be made in writing via e-mail or post to the GCBA. Refunds will be granted until June 1st.
- Granville County Beekeepers Association reserves the right to use any photographs taken at the event.
- Late vendors may be accepted until space is full.
