BRIDGE ACTIVITIES

Benetka Rd. Bridge

Hosted by youth OPPORTUNITIES! / A-Tech Special Grants. Chili, cornbread, coffee and water, baked goods, handmade youth items, and a fall photo spot. Proceeds help youth facing education and employment barriers.

Caine Rd. Bridge

Hosted by First Congregational United Church of Christ of Conneaut. Quilt and art raffle tickets, bake sale, and a photo op with the bridge as a backdrop.

Creek Road Bridge

Hosted by Stepping Stones Solutions LLC Steppin' Out Independence Program and Katie Krieger. CF boutique for Cystic Fibrosis Awareness, warming center and youth center tables, cotton candy, lemonade, family crafts, Angels of the Lake, bounce house, kids' activities, and food, drinks, and snacks by donation. Saturday plaque dedication honoring Bob Marcy.

Doyle Rd. Bridge

Hosted by Boy Scout Troop 41. Fresh cobbler, hot dogs, and hot and cold drinks by donation, plus a photo setup.

Giddings Rd. Bridge

Open with no activities.

Graham Rd. Bridge

Hosted by East Jefferson Grange. "Picnic in the Bridge" picnic boxes with soup choice, pumpkin bread, an autumn dessert, and hot apple cider or hot chocolate. Also homemade crafts, bake sale, and photo décor.

Harpersfield Bridge

Hosted by the festival board. Vendors, official souvenir booth, entertainment, strolling entertainers, food trucks, coloring mural, kiddie train rides, and other activities.

Liberty St. Bridge

Hosted by Helping Hands Farm Animal Rescue. Food and drinks, 50/50, duck pond game, cowboy hats, and picture props near the shortest bridge. Proceeds support the rescue.
