The judging stand will be located in front the Town Hall Building. The parade will Start at the Jefferson Area High School and will end at Giddings Park at that point, Antique Cars will turn right on to Market Street to the Park at the Festival Grounds, all other units will turn left to Methodist Church Parking Lot.

Ashtabula County Covered Bridge Festival Parade Rules

Please read and review all the rules of the parade before it begins. Please keep all in your group in your mustering area and do not disturb private property, remain until the parade has moved forward. Leave 30 feet between you and the unit in front of you. Pause in front of the announcer stand.

NO THROWING OF ANY MATERIALS DURING THE PARADE. CANDY, BALLOONS, ETC., CAN BE HANDED TO THE CROWD BY WALKING INDIVIDUALS.

NO SIGNS INDICATING POLITICAL CANDIDACY WILL BE ALLOWED.

HORSE PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO CLEAN UP THEIR DEBRIS FROM THE ANIMALS BEFORE LEAVING AND DURING THE PARADE.

The parade will be held regardless of weather as scheduled. The only cancellation will be due to a serve storm and will be announced on the radio.

According to **Ohio Revised Code 4511.51 & 4511.99** passengers are prohibited from riding in an open bed of a pickup without the tailgate latched and on top of an automobile. All doors to an automobile must be closed.

Please be sure that your unit is in place as the parade will leave promptly.
