ROTC Leadership Award

The Military Order of the Purple Heart Award recognizes demonstrated leadership ability in a cadet/midshipman enrolled in a JROTC program in a High School, College, University or Trade School. This award consists of a medal pendant with ribbon, a separate ribbon bar and a folder with certificate.

- Eligibility Requirements: Each cadet/midshipman must:
- Be an Underclassman (Seniors ARE NOT eligible);
- Have a positive attitude toward ROTC/JROTC and country
- Hold a leadership position in the cadet corps;
- Be active in school and community affairs;
- Attain a grade of “B” or better in all subjects for the previous semester; and
- Not been a previous recipient of this award.
