The Military Order of the Purple Heart Auxiliary, Incorporated (MOPHA) is pleased to announce that a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 is available to Purple Heart recipients, parents, spouses, widows, widowers, siblings, children, grandchildren, adopted children, nephews, nieces, and direct lineal descendants of combat veterans of the United States, who for their valiant service have been awarded the PURPLE HEART (founded by General George Washington in 1782). The Purple Heart recipient or descendant of a Purple Heart recipient is eligible to apply for the scholarship if their sponsor at the time of application, is a current member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart or was killed in action or died of wounds suffered in action (when paperwork is presented). A Purple Heart recipient who is not a member of the MOPH can become a member by applying online on the MOPH website:

www.purpleheartsa.us **Qualified applicants** are defined as a Purple Heart recipient, spouse, widow, widower, sibling, child, grandchild, adopted child, stepchild, nephew, niece or direct lineal descendent of a Purple Heart recipient.

All required information **MUST BE SUBMITTED** by April 1, 2021.

All applicants will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and the recipient will be recognized at our organization's meeting June 5, 2021.

ELIGIBILITY: Purple Heart recipient is defined as an individual, who at the time of application, is a current member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart or was killed in action or who died of wounds suffered in action (when paperwork is presented). A Purple Heart recipient who is not a member of the MOPH can become a member by applying online on the MOPH website www.purpleheartsa.us.

Qualified Applicants are defined as Purple Heart recipients, spouses, widows, widowers, siblings, children, grandchildren, adopted children, stepchildren, nephews, nieces, and direct lineal descendants of a Purple Heart recipient who reside in the state of Texas and plan to attend a public college, university, or other institution of higher learning in the state of Texas.
