The Purple Heart recipient or descendant of a Purple Heart recipient is eligible to apply for the scholarship if their sponsor at the time of application, is a current member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart or was killed in action or died of wounds suffered in action (when paperwork is presented). A Purple Heart recipient who is not a member of the MOPH can become a member by applying on line on the MOPH website: www.purpleheartsa.us

Qualified applicants are defined as a Purple Heart recipient, spouse, widow, widower, sibling, child, grandchild, adopted child, stepchild, nephew, niece or direct lineal descendent of a Purple Heart recipient.

All required information **MUST BE SUBMITTED** by April 5, 2020. All applicants will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and the recipient will be recognized at our organization's meeting June 6, 2010.

Qualified Applicants are defined as Purple Heart recipients, spouses, widows, widowers, siblings, children, grandchildren, adopted children, stepchildren, nephews, nieces and direct lineal descendants of a Purple Heart recipient who reside in the state of Texas and plan to attend a college, university or other institution of higher learning in the state of Texas.
